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# PREFACE REFACE



### 一个用于工作的起居室

很明显,科技的发展给世界各地的工作条件带来了巨大的改变。如果回头看看,我们就会意识到,几个世纪的时间,我们就从主导的农耕文化过渡到了工业文化,从以 田地为主要工作场所过渡到了以工厂为主要工作场所,仅 仅就是为了在服务的社会或是知识的文化中完成使命,在 这里,"办公室"是一个绝好的办公场所。

从田地发展到有座椅的办公室已经产生了一些消极的 结果。办公室已经成为了一个不确定的场所、一个有争议 的地方。我们过多地依赖机械系统,滥用了基于人工泡沫 概念的气候变化,夸大了机械原理的作用。对于周边的环 境条件以及图像和严格的空间布局,并不太重视。这就对 我们的第三空间造成了本质的伤害,有碍人类健康。另外, 办公大楼的功能性以及从生态角度来看的非持续性、巨大 的能源消耗和成本等都对建筑本身有负面的影响。毫无疑 问,这个刚刚开始的知识社会有责任把我们的办公室变成 真正舒服的地方。

### "A LIVING ROOM DESTINED FOR WORK"

It is obvious that recent technological development has caused a true change in workplace conditions in many places all around the world. If we look back, we will realize that in just a few centuries, we have gone from a predominant agrarian culture, the fields being the common workplace, to an industrial one, where the factory was the place to work, only to finish off in a society of services or culture of knowledge, where the "office" is the workplace par excellence.

This attractive panorama which has enabled us to travel from the fields to the ergonomic office chair has also had some negative consequences. The office has turned into an uncertain place and a matter of debate. We have abused the excessive reliability of mechanical systems, a climate based on the artificial bubble concept, an exaggerated mechanism doctrine. There has been a certain disregard for the surrounding conditions together with an iconic and strictly spatial obsession. This has caused our tertiary spaces to be essentially harmful, somewhat insalubrious; discredited by their functionality and non-sustainable, from an ecological point of view, due to their great energy impact and cost. Without a doubt, this society of knowledge that is just starting has the duty to turn our offices into places of true comfort.

**PHOTOGRAPHER** Tamás Bujnovszky The office building, located on the site of KönyvesKálmánkrt, was realized within the investment of K3IngatlanKft belonging to the concern of Wing Zrt. The main constructor was Market Zrt. Our office won the commission for the design after the Client's evaluation of all the plans prepared by the invited architects. In our opinion, the key of our success was the rational butible layout system and space organization that had been crystallized through many years of experience, as well as the dynamic but manageable volume of the building complex; and last but not least the resolution of the high Breeam grade stainable principles—which promise has come through by time.

The building was first designed along the concept of a rentable office system, counting on a shell and core layout and the further option of 10-20 fit out phases. However, in the end the final result could become very satisfying thanks to the one and only user, a real owner of the house, so the construction was finished as a united whole, meeting the emerged requirements. We are very glad that in the taut market situation of present times this very building was found attractive and appropriate for such an ambitious client as the company of Allianz.

At arrival, the building welcomes us with its entrance placed into the center of gravity of the volume as well as with a double-height representative central hall and reception space, from which the two vertical communication cores can be reached directly. Also from this space open the office building's own restaurant, café and the terrace of the inner side of the plot, the latter is completed with green surface. On the 1st floor, the two office areas are connected through a bridge spanning the void of the entrance hall, on the upper floors the layouts make up a united whole. The directors' offices are placed on the 7th floor, provided by large roof terraces. Also the mechanical rooms and the cooling machines can be found here, hidden behind noise protection walls in an optically covered arrangement. Car parking is solved by a 3-storey underground garage.
