如何快速提高听力水平,如何适应新的考试形式,顺利通过并取得优良成绩,是广大师生共同关心的热点。鉴于此,我们根据《大学英语四级考试大纲》以及《全千全国大学的通四级考试采用新题型的通知》,精心编著了这本《大学英语四级考试听力测试与突破最新

随着我国改革开放逐步深化,对外交流日益扩大,社会对英语教学的要求越来越高。客观形势要求我们不仅能够用英语书面语传递、获取信息,而且要能用英语进行直接的思想交流。而进行语言交流,听懂是首当其冲。因此,《大学英语教学大纲》对大学英语听力教学提出了明确的要求:其目的是要"培养学生有一定的听的能力"。为了达到这一目的,各类高等学校的英语教学都作了一定的调整,国家教委对大学英语教学的测试也相应地有了一些变化:一是增加新题型;二是题型不再是一成不变,每次考试都有可能在一定的范围内变动。

迄今为止,在大学英语四级考试中,国家教委正式采用的听力部分的测试题有四种题型(包括新题型):简短对话(Short Conversations);听写填空(Spot Dictation);短文理解(Short Passages)和复合式听写(Compound Dictation)。

简短对话(Short Conversations)一般有 10 道题,主要检测考生能否听懂日常对话的能力。听写填空(Spot Dictation)是一段 120 词左右的短文,其中有 10 个空格,每个空格要求填入一个句子或者句子的一部分。此部分侧重考核学生的微听写能力。短文理解(Short Passages)一般有三篇短文,每篇短文后有三至四道问答题。此题型信息容纳量大,不仅要求学生能听懂全文,而且对一些具体的细节要强化记忆。复合式听写(Compound Dictation)由两部分组成:第一部分是听写单词,要求考生在空格中填入所缺单词;第二部分是表达部分,要求考生根据所听内容写出中心要点。此题型旨在考核学生的听的能力,拼写能力,记笔记能力和书面表达能力。

全书练习题和模拟题配有答案,录音文字材料以及配套磁带,供学生练习和使用。

由于编者水平有限,书中不足之处,恳请广大读者批评指正。
