They walked by the Hall of Dinosaurs.


Arthur raised his hand again.

Arthur raised his hand again.


"Okay, Arthur," said Mr. Ratburn.

Arthur asked.






"Yes, Arthur," said Mr. Ratburn.

"The boys' room is around the corner.


It's the first door on your left."

He turned the corner and went into the first door—





"It sure is dark in here," said Arthur to himself.


He saw another door.
