上面对话中既有正式场合的介绍，也有非正式场合的引见。介绍是社交常见的礼仪活动，遵循介绍的语言规范和行为规范有助于社交活动的开展，有助于增进相互之间的友谊并建立新的社交关系。交往中是通过他人介绍还是自我介绍要视情况而定。介绍人的基本规则是：向长者介绍年轻者，向女士介绍男士，向地位高者介绍地位低者。自我介绍很简单，一方只要走上前说声“Hello!”，通报姓名并介绍个人情况就可以了，对方听到后自然就会做出反应。当然，介绍有正式和非正式之分，这要视年龄、地位和介绍场所而定，同时使用的语言差别也很大，要特别注意。商业介绍与一般的社交惯例不同。在商界，介绍不分性别和年龄，一般是把地位低的人介绍给地位高的人。如果两人地位相同且有女士，则先介绍女士。男人被介绍给比他地位低的女士时，女士无须起立。在办公室里，女士见高级官长进来应起立，见到直属上级进来则无须起立。

上述对话都含有问候语。前两者比较随便，而后者比较正式。在英美文化中，问候标志着交际开始，它具有建立和延续人际关系的作用。问候的形式受时间、地点、场合、地位、年龄、关系远近等因素影响。熟人相见要互致问候；在有人介绍认识之后即使是陌生人也要互致问候。互致问候可以用语言，也可以点头、微笑或打手势等。用英语问候要熟记一些套语，因为汉英问候语差别极大。比如，我们用汉语式的问候语“你吃了吗”问候，西方人会觉得不可思议。

很多场合我们需要了解对方的姓名。询问对方姓名的语言与所在的场合、双方的地位、双方关系的亲密程度有密切的联系, 交往中需要注意。了解姓名以后还要注意恰当的使用称谓。英美人在称呼别人时有三种方式: 第一种是称呼其名, 并且往往用简略形式。如把Thomas叫做Tom, 把Jennifer叫做Jenny, 等等。第二种是在被称呼者姓名前面加上称谓词“Mr.”、“Mrs.”和“Miss”。

“Mr.”用于男子, 婚否不论; “Mrs.”用于已婚女子, 后面加上丈夫的姓; “Miss”用于未婚女子。西方女权运动后, 出现了“Ms”这个称谓词, 以便能够在语言称谓上与男性平等。相对而言, 这个词在美国使用范围要广一些。第三种是直呼某人的职称或头衔, 如Professor、Doctor、Governor等。在称呼时要注意, 英国人似乎没有美国人那么随便。通常, 在英国只有熟人之间才以名相称。有的英语学习者按我们中国的习惯称呼老师, 如“Teacher Wang”, 这也不符合美人的习惯, 因为“teacher”一词表示的是职业的名称而非称谓。
