



近年来,来华参观游览、投资经商、留学和探亲访友的海外人士与日俱增,中国是世界上集国际交往、商贸、旅游于一体的热点目的地之一,同时国内出国游也蓬勃发展,中国的旅游业突飞猛进地发展。为了向世界展示中国的风采,让外国人了解中国、认识中国,让国人,尤其是导游人员能更好地向海外游客及友人介绍、宣传中国并提供优质的服务,做好出入境旅游的工作,《导游英语实务教程》一书应运而生。

本书初稿写于2006年,始为南京信息工程大学英语专业本科大学生的商务及旅游讲授教材。通过2006—2010年对历届学生的教学实践,数次删改,编撰为《导游英语实务教程》一书。经过数年的教学实践,笔者在旅游形势发展及旅游实践变化的情况下,根据国家旅游局《关于改革导游人员资格考试、等级考核及旅行社经理资格认证工作的意见》的精神,对原书内容进行了充实、审定和改编。

本书编者在多年的旅游导游及旅游教学工作中,共接待过来自美国、加拿大、英国、荷兰、澳大利亚、新加坡、巴基斯坦、印度等国家的旅游团队 30 多个,积累了大量的涉外工作经验及导游教学经验。

在编写过程中,本书充分吸取了以往相关教材编写的经验,在体例、内容、写作特点等方面作了新的调整。从导游人员的职业特点出发,重新设计了体例,力求使教材的结构更加合理,突出导游人员应该具备的英语技能,特别结合出入境导游实务,着眼于专业英语导游人才的能力培养,强调理论与操作实例相结合,并力求文字简练,实用性强。本书可作为针对导游人员资格考试的教材,也可作为中、高等院校相关专业的教材。同时我们也希望本书能成为广大旅游爱好者的有益读物。

由于编者水平有限,疏漏之处在所难免,敬请同行批评指正。

Now, we are heading for our hotel, the Lake View Hotel, a luxurious four-star hotel located right on the famous West Lake. It takes about 40 minutes. So please sit back and relax yourselves while I'm giving you some general information of our city.

B: That's great.

A: Here is the largest river in our province, Qiantang River. It covers a distance of 610 kilometers and is known for its tidal bores.

B: Right. I've heard of it before and once saw it on TV. It was fascinating.

A: Now we have come to the lake side. Most part of the lake is lighted. When the lights are on, it's really attractive.

B: It must be! But we are also looking forward to seeing it in day time tomorrow.

A: Tomorrow comes very soon. And here is our hotel. Good night and have a good stay!

Scene 2

(A: Guide B: Tourist)

A: Good evening, Madam and Sir. Welcome to Hangzhou.

B: Thank you. Thank you for your coming to meet us.

A: It's my pleasure. Now you've arrived at the Paradise on Earth.

- **B**: Yes. We've heard of Hangzhou many times as the Paradise on Earth. What does "Hangzhou" actually mean?
- **A:** This is a real good question. According to the geological research, the present city proper was part of the sea in the ancient times. If people wanted to come here, they could only come by boat. For that meaning in Chinese "Hang" is the word. And "Zhou" simply means an area.
- B: Thank you very much. And what is Hangzhou famous for?
- **A**: In general, Hangzhou is famous for its long history, beautiful scenery and abundant products. I'll give you more details while our trip goes on.
- **B**: This is our first trip to your city. I was told it was a very popular scenic city among the Chinese.
- A: They are right. In China, there is an old saying which goes like this: Up in heaven there is paradise, down on Earth there are Suzhou and Hangzhou^{\$\scrt{S}\$}. So, Chinese people consider Hangzhou as the Paradise on Earth. Hangzhou saw its heyday during the Southern Song Dynasty, when it served as the capital for the whole China. Thus, Hangzhou is one of the six ancient capital cities in China.
- **B**: How big is the city of Hangzhou?
- **A:** The city covers an area of 3,068 square kilometers with a population of 689 million. And it is still growing.
- B: Look, there is a suspension bridge straight ahead of us.
- **A**: Yes. The suspension bridge we are on is called Qiantang Bridge No. 3. Qiantang Bridge No. 1 is on your left hand side and No. 2 is on your right. We will build altogether 10 bridges across this river in the near future.
- **B**: China is developing so fast. The whole country is like a huge construction site. No wonder people say the national bird of China is the crane.
- **A:** You bet. Look at the skyscraper[®] on your right. This is the second tallest building in Hangzhou—the Telecommunication Tower. It has 44 stories and is approximately 220 meters high.
- **B**: I can see the city is growing fast.
- A: Yes. It is growing taller and bigger. Now we are on a new road leading to



the West Lake.

- B: Oh, what a beautiful lake!
- A: This is the famous West Lake in Hangzhou. Strange enough, there are altogether 36 west lakes in China. But this one overshadows all the others.
- **B**: How interesting! What are those plants in the lake?
- A: They are lotus. The West Lake is famous for its lotus blossom in summer. Here we are at the Shangri-la Hotel. I'll ask the bellboy to take care of your luggage and I will help you to check in.
- B: Thank you.



Introduction to Hangzhou

Since ancient times, Hangzhou has been noted as a land flowing with milk and honey, if not an out-and-out Shangri-la. As the existing records hold it, a long, long time ago, this place was but a vast body of water connected with the present-day Pacific. An emperor journeyed here by boat for inspection. His boat was moored somewhere about today's Children's Palace of the city. Now to mark his trip the emperor named the place "Yuhang" which was later converted into Hangzhou, which literally means a place accessible only by boat.

The city rose to fame after the Grand Canal was completed in the Sui Dynasty some 1,300 years ago. In the ensuing years, several kingdoms set up their capitals here. It was in the Southern Song Dynasty that Hangzhou saw its heyday. In 1275 the Italian traveler Marco Polo paid a visit to Hangzhou during his term of office as an envoy in the Yuan Dynasty. Under his pen, the city was depicted as "the most elegant and graceful city on earth".
