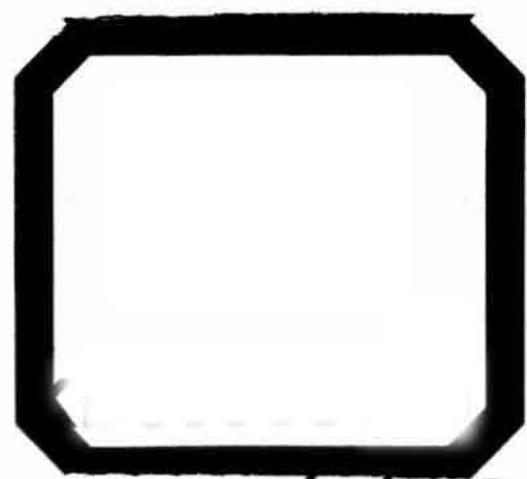

口语涵盖的范围很广，俚语、词组、成语及日常短句都可以看成口语的一部分。虽然有可能是非正式的句型或语法中的特例，但因其简单通俗的特性，也会在日常生活中被普遍使用。

在适当的时机回答上一句切合场合的口语，是许多英语学习者都想达到的目标。不希望在老外面前总是回答OK、Yes、I know……等容易冷场的句子吧？那么就从这本《生活口语关键句》开始吧！我们收录了150则用法地道的实用短句，并搭配部分举一反三的互动对话，让你的英语口语不再打结。

为了让英语学习更轻松有趣，我们按字数顺序分为9个单元，内容包含下列几个部分：首先，每小节第一部分以中英对照的方式呈现一句口语，并说明其涵义及使用时机，之后提供例句、情境对话来帮助读者了解用法以加深印象。第二部分为延伸学习，提供与该口语相关的类似说法，例如中文的“我同意、我也这么觉得”，英文就有 I have you、I agree、I have ya、I'm with you、I feel the same way 等各种不同的说法，一网打尽所有常用的口语。接下来，从第二部分的句子中挑选一至两个口语，补充说明有趣的典故或特殊的用法，让你在学习英语的同时能获得更多的语言知识。例如在口语 don't try to brownnose me（别想拍马屁）中，我们会告诉你为什么咖啡色的鼻子会被用来形容拍马屁——因为它形容的是一个人为了达到目的，不惜跟前跟后地奉承，脸都贴到别人的屁股上了，以至于鼻子沾到了咖啡色的排泄物。用这样的方式来学习口语是不是更有趣呢？

此外，我们挑选了使用频率较高的几十个句子编排成“举一反三”版块，把口语融入对话中，并提供不同情境的延伸说法，让你可以适时表达自己的想法。另外，英文除了要能听得懂，还要能说出口，随书搭配的MP3收录了外籍老师录制的正确发音，让你能边听边学，进而会听也会说。

句子是说英语的基础，希望本书实用的口语让你在与别人交谈时不再支支吾吾，能自信满满地应答如流。

anytime 是回应别人道谢时的用语，常与 forget it、forget about it 合用，比方说：

情境对话

A: Thank you very much!

真的很谢谢你！

B: Hey, anytime. Forget it.

不客气啦，不用放在心上。

延伸学习

你还可以这么说：

No sweat. 小意思。

Don't mention it. 不足挂齿。

No problem. 没问题。

说明 no problem 主要有两个意思，一是字面意思的“没问题”，主要用于响应别人的请求；另一则是指“不用客气”。一般不会用在书面语中。另外 de nada 也用来表示“没什么”，其字面意思就是 of nothing。

附带一提，sure 和 you bet 原来的意思都指“当然”，也可用来回应他人的道谢，这里可用作“不谢；不敢当”。

你也可以这么说，不过语气上较为正式！

You're welcome. 不客气。

My pleasure. 我的荣幸。

A: Thanks for all your help.

谢谢你鼎力相助。

B: My pleasure.

这是我的荣幸。

举一反三

A: Here, let me give you a hand.

来吧，我来帮你忙。

B: Thanks.

谢谢。

A: Anytime.

不客气。

说明

A. 主动提供协助。你也可以这么说：

- Here, let me do this.
- Here, I got this one.
- Let me take care of this one.
- I got this one covered.

B. 表达谢意。可以这么说：

- Thank you very much.
- I'm really grateful.
- I don't know how to thank you.

不太需要帮忙可以这么说：

- Thanks anyway.
- I'm sure you meant well.

不太领情、甚至有嘲讽的口吻则会说：

- Nice try.
- Smooth move.
- Way to go.
- I'm speechless.

A. anytime 表示不客气。也可以这么说：

- The pleasure is mine.
- My pleasure.
- It was nothing.

在国外 **cheers** 并不是真的把杯中物喝光，而只是饮用前的一个招呼说法。在英国 **cheers** 也有“谢谢”的意思。

情境对话

A: I want to toast the new bride and groom.
我要向新娘、新郎敬酒。

B: Cheers!
干杯!

延伸学习

你还可以这么说:

Bottoms up. 干了。

Chug! Chugalug! 喝! 喝光!

Down the hatch! 干杯!
