B

In order to study enzymes(酶), a small piece of potato is cut into very thin slices(薄片). These slices are placed in a little glass container(容器) and covered with water. Then a little of the proper chemical is added. Instantly, because of the enzyme present in the potato slices, the chemical starts joining with the oxygen in the air above the water. If the container is entirely closed, a partial vacuum(真空) is formed inside. If the container is now connected with a fine tube which is dipped in water, the water is sucked part way up the tube because of the vacuum.

The scientist doing the experiment carefully notes how far up the tube the water is sucked in a certain time. The higher it is sucked, the more of that particular enzyme is in the potato. In this way, we can get exact ideas about quantities of enzyme and even about the manner in which it operates. And all the time we're working with amounts far too small to see or weigh.
