本丛书根据统编教材和教学大纲，结合高考实际，编写目的有二：1.提高学生的两个能力，即英语语言能力和应考能力；2.为高中师生提供丰富、方便的语言训练材料。主要目的是培养语言能力，因为提高语言能力是教学的宗旨，是高考得高分的基础，也是避免高分低能的重要途径。本丛书各册分单项训练和综合测试两大部分，通过大量的单项训练，使学生牢固掌握必要的语言知识和技能，提高阅读，习作，改错，完形填空和语音、语法、拼写的单项选择等能力。在此基础上进行综合测试，培养应考能力。我们认真研究了教学大纲和教材，分析了历年高考试题，选出了常考、必考、难记、易混的知识点和容易得分的题，编入了单元检测题和综合训练题。

本书为《高中英语综合技能训练》丛书第二册，是根据教学大纲和现行统编教材高中《英语》第二册编写，供高二年级全学年使用。其目的是为师生提供与教材配套使用的综合训练与测试，帮助学生复习、巩固所学的语言知识，培养和提高学生综合运用英语的实际能力。
