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#### 前 言

本书是根据中学英语教学大纲编写的。

近几年来,在高考和英语教学中,选择题这一形式获得 越来越广泛的应用,究其原因,是同选择题给出的答案常常 是似是而非,且考核面广、量多的特点分不开的。这样就要 求学生真正牢固地、熟练地掌握其所学的知识,以便从往往 只有细微差别的几个答案中挑选出正确的一个。

为了帮助学生在答题过程中依靠理解而不是依靠猜测来 选择正确的答案,本书对每道选择题都进行了分析,说明为 什么要选这个而不选其它几个答案,说明那些貌似相同的答 案的区别,它们各自应用的场合和条件,还对答案所涉及的 语法、词组辨析等作了详细叙述,并就该词(或词组)在不同 场合运用的词性和词义作了极其扼要的分析和说明。本书采 用由浅入深,从一般到综合的编写方法,力求做到解答疑难, 文字清楚明白,分析答案简明扼要。因此,学生在使用本书 以后,不仅知道应如何解答本书中的各道题目,也为解答其 它选择题打下了良好的基础。

鉴于本书涉及的是普通的英语知识,所以不仅适合中学 生阅读,也可供其它方面的人员学习英语时参考。

在编写过程中,遗漏、错误在所难免,望使用者指出。
