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前 言

本书是根据《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求（试行）》和最新《高职高专英语应用能力考试大纲》编写而成。旨在帮助学生巩固所学知识，把握高等学校英语应用能力考试（B级）的命题原则、规律、题型和答题技巧并顺利通过考试。全书共分两部分，具体内容如下。

1. 高等学校英语应用能力考试（B级）真题

本部分收录了2010年6月至2014年12月高等学校英语应用能力考试（B级）真题10套，根据最新考试大纲对每套题做了适当的调整，适于教师和学生进行实战测试和演练。

2. 高等学校英语应用能力考试（B级）真题精解

（1）听力部分。本部分包含听力原文及答案。提示答案的重点词汇或句子均在听力原文里用阴影标注，便于学生掌握听力技巧。

（2）词汇和语法部分。本部分由【答案】【考点】【译文】【分析】四部分组成，部分题目还给出了相应的【考点链接】，答案和译文准确无误，分析透彻精练，考点链接到位。

（3）阅读理解部分。本部分由【核心词汇】【参考译文】【答案】【考点】【分析】五部分组成，核心词汇有助于学生夯实词汇，参考译文有助于学生理解文章，分析中提供解题依据，为学生指点迷津，助其掌握答题技巧。

（4）翻译部分。本部分由【答案】【考点】【分析】【参考译文】组成，分析重点词汇和语法结构，提示翻译技巧。

（5）写作部分。本部分由【考点】【点睛】【参考范文】【词汇和句型】组成，能使学生熟练掌握写作格式、常用词汇和句型，提高写作技巧。

本书附有B级测试项目、内容、题型、评分标准及时间分配表，配套的真题听力音频可登陆科学出版社职教技术出版中心网站（www.abook.cn）下载。
