## DESCRIPTION OF COURSES

### Explanation.

The numbering of courses in the following list is intended to indicate in which year the course is offered. Courses numbered from one to ten, are given in the freshman year; those from eleven to twenty in the sophomore year. Courses numbered above one hundred are given in the junior and senior years, and are open to any men in those two classes provided they have the necessary pre-requisites. (In some cases a course may be numbered 1 and be given in the sophomore year. If this happens it is due to the fact that it is the first course in that subject given in the college.)

In the case of elective courses the college does not undertake to give courses for which less than five men register, (for 1927-28, three men).

### ASTRONOMY

#### **Astronomy 101. Descriptive Astronomy. —3**

This course is open to Arts or Science students, who desire to elect it. It covers a description of the members of the solar system, and of the stars in general, with a brief study of time measurements and astronomical phenomena.

Three hours a week with occasional observatory and field work. Spring semester.

Pre-requisite: Freshman Mathematics.

Text: Moulton—Introduction to Astronomy.

#### **Astronomy 102. Astronomical Problems. (Mathematics 122) 3**

This course includes observation and calculation of simple problems on time, places of stars, longitude, latitude, and eclipses, and is designed to give familiarity with use of the Nautical Almanac, and with the sextant, equatorial telescope and meridian circle.

Three hours a week with observatory work. Offered on request.

Pre-requisite: Spherical Trigonometry.

Text: Assigned references.

### BIOLOGY

#### **Biology 3-4. General Biology. 4—4.**

This is a foundation course required of all college students. Fundamental principles of living organisms are taken up in an effort to help the student to understand the world about him and his rela-



tion to it. In the laboratory a study of common forms of life is made and on the field trips animals and plants are studied in their native environment.

Three recitations and one double laboratory period throughout the year.

Required of all freshmen.

Text: Woodruff, "Foundations of Biology."

**Biology 113. Invertebrate Zoology.**

4—

An advanced course in invertebrate zoology for pre-medical students and teachers of biology. Most of the time is given to the dissection and drawing of type specimens in the laboratory. Lectures and quizzes are given periodically.

One recitation and three double laboratory periods per week. Fall semester.

Pre-requisite: Biology 3-4.

Required of Biology-Chemistry men.

Text: Hegner, "College Zoology"; Pratt, "Laboratory Manual of Invertebrate Zoology."

Reference: Parker & Haswell, "Textbook of Zoology."; Thomson, "Outlines of Zoology." and others.

**Biology 114. Vertebrate Zoology.**

—4.

Covering the same ground as Biology 113 in Vertebrate Zoology. One lecture and three double laboratory periods per week.

Spring semester.

Pre-requisite:—Biology 3-4.

Required of pre-medical and Chemistry-Biology men.

Text: Hegner, "College Zoology."; Pratt, "Laboratory Manual of Vertebrate Zoology." References as above.

**Biology 121—122 Advanced Botany.**

4—4.

A course in botany for pre-medical students and teachers of botany. Most of the time is given to laboratory work and field trips. The abundant material found in the river, streams, paddy fields and pools, and the West Lake furnish the basis of the work. Experiments in plant physiology, the preparation and study of microscopic slides and the collection of herbaria are features of this course.

One lecture and three double laboratory periods per week throughout the year.

Required of Chemistry-Biology men.

Pre-requisite: Biology 3-4.
