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本书收录GRE 3041个核心词汇，相比上一版，删除了部分低频词，新增2014年以来GRE考试中出现的新词。单词释义参照《韦氏大学词典》及《美国传统词典》，用下划线标记出核心含义，便于考生迅速把握单词的特征。所有单词逆序排列，避免只是记住单词位置而不是单词意思的情况。本书是《GRE核心词汇考法精析》（第2版）的浓缩精华版，可与其配合使用，相得益彰。

ironclad ['aɪərnklæd] *adj.* 非常坚固的，坚不可摧的：so firm or secure as to be unbreakable

nomad ['noumæd] *adj./n.* 游牧的；居无定所的人：a member of a people who have no fixed residence but move from place to place usually seasonally and within a well-defined territory

goad [gōd] *vt.* 刺激，驱使，激发：to incite or rouse as if with a goad

embed [ɪm 'bed] *vt.* 嵌入：to enclose closely in or as if in a matrix

self-absorbed [selfəb'sɔ:rbd] *adj.* 自恋的，自私的：absorbed in one's own thoughts, activities, or interests

barefaced ['berfeɪst] *adj.* 公然的，厚颜无耻的：undisguisedly bold; brazen

wrongheaded [rɒŋ 'hedɪd] *adj.* 固执己见的，坚持(错误观点)的：stubborn in adherence to wrong opinion or principles

levelheaded ['levl'hedɪd] *adj.* 明智的：characteristically self-composed and sensible

jaded ['dʒeɪdɪd] *adj.* 厌倦的，没兴趣没热情的：having one's patience, interest, or pleasure exhausted

lopsided [lə:p 'saɪdɪd] *adj.* 不平衡的，不协调的：lacking in balance, symmetry, or proportion
