

# 内容提要

《医学英语听力综合教程II——医疗服务新思路》共15单元,每单元由4个音视频以精听、泛听构成主题式听力。所有视听说练习均围绕内容以预测、听写、听记、问答、复述、模仿、表达、听译、归纳等多种形式展开。整体编排注重系统性、知识性与实用性。

本书的主要内容包括远程医疗、医疗体制、医疗改革、医疗应急机制、医疗质量、医护患关系、疾病诊断、机器人手术、太空医学、医疗技术、器官移植与捐赠等当今热门话题。

## PREFACE



《医学英语听力综合教程》(Advanced Listening Course for Medical Professionals) 共有《公共健康新识》(New Perspectives of Public Health)、《医疗服务新思路》(New Approaches to Medical Practice)及《疾病诊治新探索》(Ongoing Researches for the Diagnosis and Treatment of Diseases) 3 册。

众多莘莘学子学习医学英语多年,往往还是找不到门,效果不佳。有3个因素可以帮助大家在较短时间走上学好英语的快速通道,重拾学习英语的乐趣,那就是兴趣、效率与信心。兴趣无疑是一个人最好的老师,无论做何事,兴趣往往是动力的最大所在。有了浓厚的兴趣和足够的好奇心还不够,方法得当很重要。有效提高医学英语听说能力,在于学会在大量实际操练中熟悉各类题型、熟练各类技巧,并加以横向联系与融会贯通。

快速、连读、缩略、口音、背景音等语言所呈现的多样性是常速听力的一道独特风景线,而这些往往成为英语学习过程中的难点。无论你的起点在哪,按自己的节奏去听。语言能力的提高是一个潜移默化、循序渐进的过程。质的飞跃离不开一定量的累积,听力累积到一定程度,你就会惊喜你领悟了! 更多的领悟带你走向顿悟! 进步了,你兴许又带着新的困惑走向新的未知地带,但那时的你却不会再像当初那样。实践,再实践,循环反复,乃至无穷,你的自信心在具体的听力实践中不断提高,你已进入有效自主学习的良性循环阶段。

顺应课堂教学的实际需求,编者给本校各医学专业的硕士研究 生开设《医学英语听力综合教程》,作为选修课选读。为满足不同层 次学习者的医学英语听力需求,将多年医学英语听说教学实践的思



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考、感悟、累积、归纳及理念充分体现在教材里,编者除注重全面培养学生听说能力外,还特设计听前预测与听后归纳供学习者不断思考与总结。
