《新SAT必背词汇2700》由睿途教育SAT/ACT教师张森、刘超然编著。本书立足于考试本身，逐篇手工摘录现有备考资源中的核心词汇，涵盖七套真题以及官方指定模拟题等海量材料，确保收录的词汇难度与考试要求相吻合。除了准确的中英文释义及例句之外，所收录词汇还配有派生词、介词搭配等辅助信息，帮助考生提升精准且全面的词汇把控能力。

前 言

PREFACE

本书的特色与定位

新 SAT 改革已经过去将近一年，但市面上的词汇书并没有及时反映出考试的变化。一个事实便足以说明问题：手头这几本现有词汇书的一个共性便是仍然收录了较多 GRE 级别的偏门形容词，对于已经缺少填空题的新 SAT 而言帮助有限，毕竟低频难词已经不再是考查侧重点。这也并不奇怪，毕竟相当一部分新 SAT 词汇书的出版时间都集中在 2016 年春季之前。但时隔半年之后的今天就不一样了，迄今为止的海量备考资源，为确定新 SAT 考试词汇难易范围提供了足够充足的样本。

通过分析真题发现，由于考查侧重点的转移，原本只需要“大概知道中文意思即可”的核心词汇，现在不仅需要准确掌握释义，还要了解搭配用法、描述对象、褒贬色彩、与其他近义词之间的细微差异，等等，才能做到作答时十拿九稳。

《新 SAT 必背词汇 2700》的优势，在于真真正正是从最新备考资源中逐篇手工摘词，涵盖阅读、语法、写作三大科目，并且结合一年多以来的新 SAT 一线教学经验，以确保所收录词汇对于考生而言不会太难、不会太易，而是严格基于真实考试的必背词汇。

本书词汇构成及编著理念

本书共收录 2700 词，以乱序方式排列，适合托福阅读 24 分左右、新 SAT 阅读 280 分左右的考生。全书 90% 词汇来源于上述备考资源，剩余 10% 为词频与难度皆类似的课外词汇，起到补充与进阶作用。

全书词汇大致可分为三大部分：基础部分（约占 20%）、核心部分（约占 50%）、进阶部分（约 30%）。基础部分收录了考生普遍掌握得不够扎实的常见学术词汇；核心部分包括四大题材通用的动词、形容词及名词；进阶部分主要由 GRE 高频词、常见学科术语以及其他文雅用词构成。

为了方便背诵，每个单词只对应一个最为准确且尽量简短的中文释义，删除了多余的近义词。为了切实帮助考生们准确掌握词汇，每个单词配有精选例句、搭配用法、派生词。希望同学们在背诵过程中尤其留意单词所搭配的介词，因为介词的变化可能会使词意发生相应改变，而且了解介词可以更快判断长句结构。

本书得益于一线教学经验的是写于附录的《使用说明》。我们见到了太多时间紧迫又缺少背单词经验的焦虑考生。每天背多少、怎么背、看中文还是看英文释义、要不要朗读、要不要默写、多久复习一次……绝大多数词汇书只是给了要背的单词，却没给出背单词的方法。我们将背诵单词的详细步骤写在了本书的最后，希望可以帮到有需要的同学们。

配套书籍推荐

想要在新 SAT 考试中取得高分，仅靠一本词汇书恐怕是不够的。除了结合平时的精读与泛读练习之外，还需要着眼于其他侧重点的配套词汇书。本书所专注的内容是单词，但略去了对于理解全文同样重要的词组及习语，这部分内容被收录进《新 SAT 必背词组 1100》；此外，新 SAT 常常会涉及熟悉词汇的生僻含义，我们对这一类最容易被考生忽视的特殊单词进行了专门汇总，出版了《新 SAT 熟词僻义 798》一书，对于历史和文学两类题材提分尤为有效。以上两本书与本书一样，都是基于新 SAT 考试素材的前提之下做了适当扩充，确保针对性和实用性。

结语

一本真正实用的好书需要立足于考试本身，这也是本书的编著宗旨。随着新 SAT 考试不断更新，我们会持续关注考试动态，确保本书每一次的修订都可以更加准确地反映新 SAT 考试对于词汇的要求，更有针对性地满足考生们的备考需求。

最后，感谢睿途教育创始人胡中华，以及杜通、刘醒在本书编著过程中提供的帮助。
