——《金版1+1高考双测》丛书主编答读者问

一问：有人说，2006年开始，在《考试大纲》之后增加的《考试说明》，又起到“半个考纲”的作用，这是什么意思？

答：2004年之前，国家考试中心命题时要在同一科目中命制几份不同的试卷，以适应不同省市的情况和要求。从2004年开始，国家考试中心把有不同情况的试卷委托给不同的省市自己制作，这是考试中心命题组的扩大，是命题机制多元化的一项改革。

2005年的《考试大纲》取消了“样卷”，给了地方命题的“试卷款式权”，各地方分别为自己的“自主命题”制定了“合法性”文件，即地方性《考试说明》。中央直接命题的考区，统一使用考试中心制定的统一的《考试说明》。

2006年，考试中心细化并扩大了国家《考试说明》，强调了国家《考试说明》对地方《考试说明》的指导作用。例如强调了“样卷”的规范性和科学性，实际上是要求地方“样卷”向全国“样卷”靠拢。这样一来，“中央命题”的“统一性”，除《考试大纲》以外，还有“半个说明”，而“地方命题”的差异性只存在于“地方说明”与“中央说明”的差异中。这就是有人说的国家的《考试说明》又起到“半个考纲”作用的来历。

二问：新版《金版1+1 高考双测》是怎样处理《考试大纲》与《考试说明》的关系的？

答：首先，中央的统一性命题仍为高考命题的主体，中央领导下的地方命题仍为附体。至于地方命题与中央命题在款式上的差别，是试题的难度和区分度的体现。

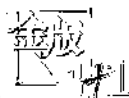
中央与地方命题的统一性和差异性，指导我们全面修订《金版1+1高考双测》丛书。新版《金版1+1高考双测》在考虑中央命题的统一性时，同时考虑了“自主命题”的差异性。对有些省市在试题难度和区分度上的不同要求，做了兼容性考虑和科学性调整，从而使得第一轮复习备考使用的新版《金版1+1高考双测》不仅适用于中央统一命题的考生，也适用于地方“自主命题”的考生。

丛书分《金版1+1高考双测—考点夯实》和《金版1+1高考双测—系统训练》两部分出版，《金版1+1高考双测—考点夯实》突出中央命题的统一性，编成了全国统用本；《金版1+1高考双测—系统训练》则要相对考虑地方命题的差异性，以区分不同考区的试题难度和区分度。比如江苏、湖北等考区，试题难度应相对提高，区分度也相对上移；而河南、北京等考区，试题难度应相对稳定，区分度也相对居中。

三问：对照“高考改革”与“课程改革”的关系，新版《金版1+1 高考双测》有哪些新意？

答：2006年的《考试大纲》相对2005年保持明显的稳定性和连续性，其原因之一，是为了与正在进行的“新课程方案”形成互动，新版《金版1+1高考双测》考虑了有以下几方面的新意：

(1) 推进新课程改革，试题向新内容倾斜：降低难度，突出新意。





(2) 推进新题型设计, 题目向新情境倾斜: 减少题量, 提高品质。

(3) 推进新高考机制, 命题向多元化探索: 交流特色, 展示个性。

由于新版《金版1+1高考双测》含有这些新意, 因此, 《金版1+1高考双测》堪称《考试大纲》与《考试说明》之后的《考试细目》, 它是对国家考试中心新的《考试大纲》与《考试说明》传神尽形的展开式解读。

四问: 新的《金版1+1高考双测》为什么要分两册出版? “小卷”与“大卷”是怎样的关系?

答: 丛书分《金版1+1高考双测—考点夯实》(简称“小卷”)和《金版1+1高考双测—系统训练》(简称“大卷”)两册出版, 首先由于强化“考点夯实”而篇幅扩大, 其次因“大卷”与“小卷”在使用关系上有个“时差”, 更主要的是为了确保“大卷”题目的新颖性以及试卷的操作性, 所以“大卷”出版的时间必须是在高考结束以后, 以利于充分吸纳当年最新的高考试题和模考题及最新的高考信息。

“小卷”由“考点小卷”和“专题小卷”组成, 大16开胶订成书; “大卷”由“单元卷”“月考卷”“专题大卷”“综合模拟卷”“地方模考卷”组成, 8开活页装订。两者的关系是为高考真卷“备料”与“造型”的关系, 两种卷的使用“时差”具体表现在以下“四先四后”的“约定”上:

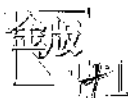
- (1) 小卷“备料”在先, 大卷“造型”在后;
- (2) 备料的“成分”在先, 造型的“图案”在后;
- (3) 成分中找到“题感”在先, 图案中找到“卷感”在后;
- (4) 小卷的“天天练”在先, 大卷的“周周测”在后。

五问: 《金版1+1高考双测》此次分版之后, 有了较多的新意, 您能具体介绍一下吗?

答: 最大的新意, 是我们对高考一轮复习认知的升华, 提出了“考大学练小卷”的理念。古人云: 志犹大而心犹小, 行欲圆而势必方。园艺家说: 欲其果而浇其根。人的目的性与其操作性在形式上有时“反向”。高考, 本是考一张大卷, 这容易让人就形式上想事, 以为只拿着这张“大卷”反复来练是走的捷径, 这实际上是在弃根求果。30年的备考经历证明, 开始不从基础干起, 一轮复习就摆开“大卷攻势”或“仿真模拟”, 到头来, 没有一个不是失败的。

“考大学, 练小卷”的理念, 使我们强化了“考点夯实”。此次分版, 我们做了五件具体事: 一是[细化考点]; 二是[广化题型]; 三是[详化解答]; 四是[核准内容]; 五是[添加模块]。在旧课程向新课程过渡中, 有些教辅出现了考点混乱现象。因为显性的题目容易更换, 而隐性的理念却不易变革。此次修订, 我们对考点核准做到了“尽其形, 归其神”。换句话说, 形式上是修修补补, 理念上却是脱胎换骨。“细化考点”的显性工作为考试内容, 隐性工作为考试要求。此次修订, 还增加了小专题模块, 专门针对《考试大纲》中的重要考点, 分“新点加浓”、“重点巩固”、“热点跟踪”、“亮点聚焦”、“难点化解”五部分进行梳理和测试。至此, 新版《金版1+1高考双测》对新的考纲保证: 要考的, 这里全有; 不考的, 这里全无!

English as a Foreign Language

Who taught you to speak English? Your parents, while you were a young child? Your teachers at school? Perhaps even the BBC as a grown-up. Whoever it was, somehow you have developed an understanding on what is rapidly becoming a truly global language.

There are now about 376 million people who speak English as their first language, and about the same number who have learnt it in addition to their mother tongue. There are said to be one billion people learning English now and about 80% of the information on the Internet is in English.

Is this a good thing, or a bad thing? Should we celebrate the fact that more and more of us can communicate, using a common language, across countries and cultures? Or should we worry about the dangers of "monoculturalism", a world in which we all speak the same language, eat the same food and listen to the same music?

Does it matter if an increasing number of people speak the same language? On the contrary, I would have thought—although I have never accepted the argument that if only we all understood each other better, there would be fewer wars. Ask the people of India (where many of them speak at least some English) and Pakistan (the same situation with India)...

If we all speak English, will we then all start eating McDonald's burgers? Surely not. If English becomes more dominant (占主导地位的), it will kill other languages? I doubt it. When I travel in Africa or Asia, I am always surprised by how many people can speak not only their own language but often one or more other related languages, as well as English and perhaps some French or German as well.

When we discussed this on *Talking Point* a couple of years ago, we received a wonderfully poetic e-mail from a listener in Ireland. "The English language is a beautiful language. Maybe it's like a rose," he said, "But who would ever want their gardens just full of roses?"

Well, I love roses, and I think they make a beautiful addition to any gardens. But the way I see it, just by planting a few roses, you don't necessarily need to pull out everything else. If more and more people want to plant

English roses, that's fine by me.

Faster Effective Reading

A higher reading rate, with no loss of comprehension, will help you in other subjects as well as in English, and the general principles apply to any language. Naturally, you will not read every book at the same speed. You would expect to read a newspaper, for example, much more rapidly than a physics or economics textbook—but you can raise your average reading speed over the whole range of materials you wish to cover so that the percentage(百分比) gained will be the same, whatever kind of reading you are concerned with.

The reading passages which follow are all of an average level of difficulty for your stage of instruction. They are all about five hundred words long. They are about topics of general interest which do not require a great deal of specialized knowledge. Thus they fall between the kind of reading you might find in your textbooks and the much less demanding kind you will find in a newspaper or light novel. If you read this kind of English, with understanding at four hundred words per minute, you might skim(浏览) through a newspaper at perhaps 650~700, while with a difficult textbook you might drop to two hundred or two hundred and fifty.

Perhaps you would like to know what reading speeds are common among native English-speaking university students and how those speeds can be improved. Tests in Minnesota, USA, for example, have shown that students without special training can read English of average difficulty, for example, Tolstoy's *War and Peace* in translation, at speeds of between 240 and 250 words per minute with about seventy percent comprehension. Students in Minnesota claim that after twelve half-hourly lessons, once a week, the reading speed can be increased, with no loss of comprehension, to around five hundred words per minute.
