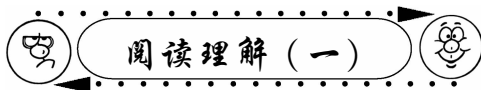

How to apply for(申请) a free mailbox? First you have to connect to the Internet and go to the homepage(主页) of the ICP providing free mailboxes. Then you will find an icon showing "apply for a free mailbox", click the icon, an agreement about the rules for using the free mailbox will appear. If you want to go on, click the icon "I agree". Then you have to fill in a form about your basic personal data, and the name and PIN of the



mailbox. The PIN is the key to the mailbox. After finishing these, you will get a mailbox like this: your name@ mail server. For example: tvguide@ mail. cctv. com. cn, "tvguide" is the name of the mailbox, and "mail. cctv. com. cn" is the name of the mail server. The mailbox is separated(分隔) into two parts by a separator "@", which is read as "at". The former part is the name of the mailbox. The latter part is the domain name(域名) of the mails' server. All mails to you will be received by the server and put into your mailbox. You can read these mails on any computer on the Internet in the world, if you have the name and PIN of the mailbox.

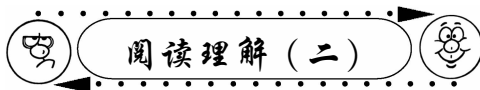

Most famous people are remembered for one thing. Henry Ford made the motor car cheap enough for ordinary family to buy. John Logie Baird invented the first television set. But what made Thomas Edison famous? The photograph? The electric light? The early cinema? Improved telephones? There are so many to choose from. There are hundreds of patents(专利) in Edison's name. He kept on inventing for more than sixty years.

He used to say, "Remember, nothing that's good work by itself, just to please you. You've got to make the thing work!" He did just that and, again and again his invention did work. He never invented anything unless he felt that there was a need for it, and that people would buy it. He once said, comparing(比较) himself with the great scientist Michael Farady, whom he greatly admired(敬佩), "I am not a scientist. I am an inventor. Farady was a scientist. He didn't work for money... He didn't have time." he said. "But I work for money. I measure everything I do by the size of the silver(银) dollar."

In actual fact, Edison was not a good businessman. He let millions of dollars slip through his fingers. But he was such a wonderful inventor that he still earned more than he could possibly spend. And he never invented anything not having definite use. We all use Edison's inventions.

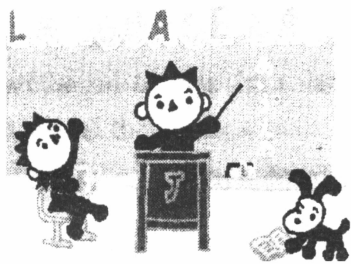

Reading for Pleasure

Reading for pleasure is the easiest way to become a better reader in English. It is also the most important way.

Some students say they don't want to read for pleasure. They say they want to use their time to learn the rules of the language and new words. They say that pleasure reading is too easy.

Many experts say pleasure reading is very important for learning English. Dr Stephen Krashen, a famous expert on learning languages, says that pleasure reading helps people learn many important things about English. Students learn more grammar rules and more words when they read for pleasure. They also learn more about good writing.

Dr Krashen tells us that pleasure reading helps each student in a different way. Each student needs to learn something different. Pleasure reading makes it possible for each student to learn what he or she needs.

Reading for pleasure is not the same as studying. When you read for pleasure, you choose your own books, and you don't have to remember everything. There are no tests on



your pleasure reading books. Pleasure reading will help you learn how English speakers use English, read faster in English, learn new words, and help you learn about the culture of English speakers.
