编者说明

书信跟日记一样,是私秘的、最能表现真性情的东西。罗老的书信跟他本人一样,绝对的朴实无华、简洁明了。只可惜能够收集到的多是他晚年写给后生晚辈的书信,而他年轻时与同侪好友如朱湘、罗皑岚、柳无忌、赵景深等频密的书来信往,却一封也没有保留下来。我们虽尽了最大的努力多方征集,终因动手太晚未能如愿。本卷所收最早的一封是朱湘沉江后罗老写给曹葆华的,弥足珍贵。罗老晚年致国际友人的几封英文信底稿保存完好,放在前面;他写给几位领导人的信紧随其后;再后面便是罗老的学生,同事等有过工作交往的人保存完好的信件。信的数量不算多,篇幅也多似便笺,却足以映照出一代宗师为人为文的可敬可爱了。

书信之后是罗老自撰档案资料摘录,因客观条件限制不能全录也。好在此摘录已忠实地勾勒出罗老一生的思想历程及奋进足迹,实属难能可贵。

所附各篇,除年表外,均为已见诸报刊杂志的文章选编。罗老的人生简历、婚姻家庭、著译成就、音容笑貌、“少年孤寒”、“中年勤苦”、“老年辉煌”等等尽在其中,实乃众手所撰罗念生小传也!

编者水平有限,不周之处在所难免,祈读者诸君不吝赐教。
