Listening is, in any case, while you drive, can improve your speed and ability to get away from accidents, according to Australian psychologists (心理学者). But turning your car into a full volume radio probably makes you end up in an accident. The performance of difficult tasks can be affected if people are subjected to loud music. The experience of pulling up at traffic lights alongside cars with loud music made some psychologists in the University of Sydney look into whether loud music did anything to do with driving.

The psychologists invited 60 men and women aged between 20 and 28 as subjects and found them to almost the same driving task under three noise conditions: silence, rock music played at a probe 55 decibels ($57\frac{1}{2}$), and the same music at 65 decibels.

For 10 minutes the subject sat in front of a screen operating a simple machine like a car. This had to track a moving dot on screen, respond to traffic signals changing color, and brake (制動) in response to arrows that appeared without warning.

第一章 时事新闻类

考纲解读

英语是获取世界各方面信息的重要工具,而时事新闻能及时快捷地把世界各地发生的重大事件以及相关信息传递到千家万户,因而时事新闻也是获取知识的一个重要的途径。时事新闻类文章关注当前发生的一些重大事件,但并不是对这些重大事件的简单追踪报道,而是选取重大事件中不易被人注意、内容新颖的“小插曲”,这是高考选择时事新闻类文章的一个标准。另外古老事件在当代所呈现出的新情况是高考选择文章的另一个标准。这样就巧妙地避免了大家熟悉的信息,而把理解的重点放在了大家不太熟悉的信息上,体现了高考阅读理解的要求。时事新闻类文章的考查趋势主要包括以下几个方面:

1. 选材:当前发生的重大事件以及古老事件在当代所呈现的新情况。
2. 命题:以细节题为主,有一定的主旨大意题、词义猜测题和推理判断题。
3. 知识:涉及各个领域的重大事件以及一定的新闻知识。

真题演练

Passage 1

He was the baby with no name. Found and taken from the north Atlantic 6 days after the sinking of the *Titanic* in 1912, his tiny body so moved the salvage (救援) workers that they called him “Our baby”. In their home port of Halifax, Nova Scotia, people collected money for a headstone in front of the baby’s grave (墓), carved with the words: “To the memory of an unknown child.” He has rested there ever since.

But history has a way of uncovering its secrets. On November 5, this year, three members of a family from Finland arrived at Halifax and laid fresh flowers at the grave. “This is our baby,” says Magda Schleifer, 68, a banker. She grew up hearing stories about a great-aunt named Maria Panula, 42, who had sailed on the *Titanic* for

America to be reunited with her husband. According to the information Mrs Schleifer had gathered, Panula gave up her seat on a lifeboat to search for her five children—including a 13-month-old boy named Eino — from whom she had become separated during the final minutes of the crossing. “We thought they were all lost in the sea.” says Schleifer.

Now, using teeth and bone pieces taken from the baby's grave, scientists have compared the DNA from the Unknown Child with those collected from members of five families who lost relatives on the *Titanic* and never recovered the bodies. The result of the test points only to one possible person; young Eino. Now the family see no need for a new grave. “He belongs to the people of Halifax,” says Schleifer. “They've taken care of him for 90 years.”

Special Bridges Help Animals Cross the Road

Most people know this joke. But recently, some people have been much more worried about how the grizzly bear and mountain lion can cross the road.

"Millions of animals die each year on US roads," the Federal Highway Administration reports. In fact, only about 80 ocelots, an endangered wild cat, exist in the US today. The main reason? Roadkill.

"Ecopassages" may help animals cross the road without being hit by cars. They are paths both over and under roads. "These ecopassages can be extremely useful, so that wildlife can avoid road accidents," said Jodi Hilty of the Wildlife Protection Society.

But do animals actually use the ecopassages? The answer is yes. Paul Beier of Northern Arizona University found foot marks left by mountain lions on an ecopassage that went under a highway. This showed that the lions used the passage.

Builders of ecopassages try to make them look like a natural part of an area of by planting trees on and around them. Animals seem to be catching on. Animals as different as salamanders and grizzly bears are using the bridges and underpasses.

The next time you visit a park or drive through an area with a lot of wildlife, look around. You might see an animal overpass!

A YOUNGSTER who was knocked off his tricycle by a taxi and left with a serious brain injury is set to be awarded £ 1.75 million.

Fourteen-year-old George Currie, from Dalkeith was living in County Durham with his parents Allister and Paula at the time of the accident in September 1993.

George, who was then three years old, was riding his small tricycle along the pavement when he lost control and swerved on to the road into the path of an on-coming taxi.

The driver's insurance company has now accepted responsibility for the accident and New Castle County Court is expected to rule on the payout on Monday.
