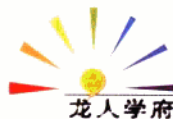

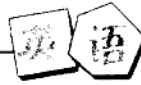

Celebrating Victoria Day

Victoria Day is a holiday all over Canada. People remember (纪念) it as "twenty-fourth of May, the Queen's birthday". In fact, it celebrates the birthdays of Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. Victoria was the queen of the United Kingdom and empress (女皇) of India. She was born on 24 May, 1819. She became the queen after the death of her uncle George IV in 1837. At that time, she was only 18 years old. She ruled (统治) until she died in 1901. Then, her son Edward VII became the king.

People began to have Victoria Day as a holiday in Canada West in 1845. In 1901, it became a national holiday. People once called it Empire Day. Now Canadians still call it Victoria Day.

In Canada, People celebrate Victoria Day on Monday, before May 25th of every year. (People in England celebrate it in June.) Canadians love to celebrate Victoria Day. There are fireworks (烟花表演) across the country on Victoria Day. Victoria Day is a time for families and friends to get together. On Victoria Day, people take a boat to play, plan a picnic in the park, and so on.
