

## 前　　言

《英语辨析大词典》终于问世了。从设计到出版,历时十年有余,其间是一个不断研究、不断锤炼、不断提升的过程。

由于独特的历史原因,英语逐步形成了广博浩瀚的词汇海洋,其中,同义词尤为绚丽多彩。几乎每一个英语词都有与之同义的词语。丰富的同义词使英语的表现力极强,然而,林林总总的同义词,有的完全同义,有的部分同义,有的意义相近;即便是完全同义词,在使用频率、位置分布及内涵意义等方面也有不同程度的细微差异。要正确理解,恰如其分地加以运用,对于以英语为母语的人来说尚且不易,对于以英语为外语的人来说,难度则更大。

《英语辨析大词典》正是为了适合中国的英语学习者和使用者实际情况而编写的一部以英语同义词为主体的工具书。全书收录常用的英语同义词、易混词及词组近 11 200 条。本词典在研究前人成果的基础上,广征博引,“以彼之丝,织我之锦”,挖掘他人之未所及,熔语义、语法、搭配、文体、修辞描述于一炉,力图使读者对英语同义词能大处见同,微处辨异,即读即用,收立竿见影之效。

本词典是由来自上海大学、上海师范大学、上海对外贸易学院、上海外国语大学等院校的英语学者和教师共三十余人,在完成繁重的教学工作之余,合力研编的;我们常为解一字之困,解一句之疑,立一意之新而食不甘味,寝不安席;“青灯黄卷”,兀兀穷年,拼搏十余寒暑,个中甘苦,不言而喻。本词典与规模相仿的同类辞书相比,如能踏上一个新的高度,即便是小小的第一步,也倍感幸甚。我们虽尽了主观努力,但由于学识浅薄,经验不足,错误和疏漏势所难免,敬希读者不吝批评指正。

在整个编写过程中,我们得到许多专家的指点、有关领导和部门的支持,尤其是华东师范大学出版社领导和外语编辑室同志的鼎力相助,在此谨向他们一并表示衷心的感谢。此外,已故的老编审张云皋先生对这部辞书的贡献,我们当永记不忘。

## 体例说明

### (一) 词条与词目

1. 词条指收入词典的整个条目。本典所收词条有英语同义、近义、相关、易混之词或词组(包括介乎词与分句之间的各种组合,如:act as, act like等)。
2. 词条分总词条和分词条。总词条包括总词目、语义场和若干分词条。一个典型的分词条包括分词目、注音、词性、英汉释义、文体标签、语义辨析、语法和搭配、例证及注解。但许多分词条并不包括上述所有项目;其主要项目一般为分词目、注音、词性、英汉释义、语义辨析及例证,其他项目则根据需要收列。
3. 词目分总词目和分词目。总词目指词条开头的一组词(或词组),第一条为中心词目,其余由分词目按字母顺序排列构成;分词目如是词组,则按中心词字母顺序排列;拼法相同而词义有异的词目列入不同词条,并在词目右上角标注1,2,3等数码。例如:  
taste<sup>2</sup> gusto palate relish zest
4. 词目如有英美拼法差异时,以英国拼写形式收入词条。

### (二) 语义场

5. 语义场用▲引导,通常说明本组同义词所具有的共同的基本意义,即是说本组同义词是在这一基本意义的前提下进行多个层面的辨析。例如:

thoughtful<sup>2</sup> attentive considerate

▲均可表示体谅、关心他人的意思。

如词目是易混词(或词组)或其他易混组合,则在语义场栏内注明是易混词(语)或易混结构。例如:

tired from tired of

▲易混词语。

又如:

try to do something try doing something

▲易混结构。

### (三) 注 音

6. 在分词目后用国际音标注明读音,英式音在前,美式音在后,用分号分隔,置于斜线号“/”之间。例如:  
impose/ɪm'paʊz; ɪm'poʊz/
7. 由两个(或两个以上的)词组组成的分词目不注读音。

### (四) 词 性

8. 词性以英语缩略形式标注。

本典采用的词性有:

名词 n.

动词 vt., vi., v. aux.

短语动词 phr. v.

形容词 adj.

副词 adv.

代词 pron.

连词 conj.

介词	<i>prep.</i>
限定词	<i>det.</i>

9. 一个词目采用一种词性。若所有分词目均具有两种(或两种以上的)相同词性表示相应意义,则以描述性强的一种词性进行辨析。其他词性则在该词条结束时予以注解,注解以◆引导。若分词目除有一种相同词性外,其中有若干词目还有一种(或一种以上)不同词性,亦表示相应意义,则在分词条结束时,予以说明,说明内容以◇引导。若分词目词性无法统一,则只保留原样,如在 explain<sup>2</sup>, account for, justify, rationalize 中, account 只作 *vi.*, 其他词都作 *vt.*。

### (五) 释义

10. 释义分英汉两种,是词条的纲目。  
 11. 英汉释义,意义相近的,用逗号;含意稍远的以及不同义项之间,用分号。  
 12. 释义用于标注词性的词目,未标词性的词目通常没有(英汉)释义,如 tired from。

### (六) 文体

13. 文体分口语体和书面体两种,分别用〈口〉与〈书〉标签表示。前者代表口语体或非正式文体;后者代表书面体或正式文体。其他各种语域特点(如古体英语、文学英语、俚语等)以及地区变体(如美国英语、英国英语)等均在语义辨析内用文字叙述。若所有分词目均可用其中一种文体标签,则该标签取消,而在本词条结束时用文字注解。

### (七) 语义辨析

14. 语义辨析用△引导,通过措词说明该词目与本词条内的其他词目相比较时,有关文体标签以外的其他语域特点、该词目的地区变体、该词目使用范畴及频率以及语义特点等。一个分词条内并不包括上述所有内容,但语义特点通常必不可少,如在分词条 charity 内,语义辨析项为:

△指慈善行为和助人的意愿,以及基督教所倡导的三德之一的仁爱。常可指公开或私下的救济。

### (八) 语法和搭配

15. 语法和搭配用○引导,通过措词说明该词目与本词条内的其他词目相比较时,语法特点与搭配关系。分词条内的语法特点一致时,则该特点取消,而在本词条结束时加以说明,说明内容以●引导。搭配亦如此。  
 16. 名词的语法与搭配主要指数以及与介词、不定式搭配的关系等。  
 17. 形容词的语法与搭配主要指比较等级、作前置修饰语、作补语以及作补语时与介词短语、不定式短语、that 分句搭配的关系等。  
 18. 不及物动词的语法与搭配主要指与介词短语、副词短语、不定式短语的搭配关系等。  
 19. 及物动词的语法与搭配主要指用被动语态、用主动语态、宾语所指(人、事物等)、单宾语的结构(名词短语、不定式短语等)、复合宾语的结构以及双宾语的结构(包括间接宾语的后移)等。

### (九) 例证

20. 例证用※引导。例句紧扣文体、语义辨析及搭配的特点。所有设例均用完整句子。中心词用黑正体印刷。例证附有汉语译文。

### (十) 注解

21. 用在主词条或分词条结尾。  
 22. 用在中心词条结尾时,用●或◆引导,主要以文字说明该词条中的词目具有同一种文体特点、语法特点或共同具有的其他词性。  
 23. 用在分词条结尾时,用◇引导,主要以文字及例证说明分词目具有相应意思时的其他词性的用法。
