




A Fateful Day

On a beach in Sri Lanka, a woman grieves over her two children lost in the tsunami of 26 December, 2004. They were two of the more than 270,000 people in Southeast Asia who lost their lives on this fateful day.

The 2004 Tsunami disaster shook the world. Before it happened, most people did not even know what a tsunami was. Then in the hours and days after the first killer waves hit the coasts of 13 Southeast Asian and African countries, the word *tsunami* was on everyone's lips.



Other natural disasters have killed more people. For example, an earthquake in Tangshan, China killed more than 240,000 people in 1976, and in 1970, a cyclone in Bangladesh killed between 300,000–500,000 people. However, because the 2004 Tsunami disaster affected areas with holidaymakers, people from over 50 countries were among the dead, making it a truly global disaster.

Natural disasters are unexpected and although you often hear about them and their destructive effects, you never imagine one happening to you. Neither did any of those 270,000 people. Knowledge is the only way to protect yourself, so read on, and learn.





A Narrow Escape




25 December, 2004
