职业高中综合英语

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前 言

职业高中、中专、技校英语课的培养目标应适应社会发展的需要,着重培养学生运用英语进行交际的能力,努力使基础知识转化为言语技能,使学生具备一定的听、说、读、写能力和接受外语职业技术教育的基础。为此,我们结合生活实际和学生今后使用英语的需要,在义务教育初中英语教材的基础上编写了这套教材。

这套教材由课本、同步训练组成,共 24 课,供职业高中、中专或技校一年级学生使用。各课由对话、课文、单词表、注释、练习等构成。

教学建议:

- 一、建议每周开设英语 3 课时,一学年 35 周,共 105 课时,每课用 4 课时完成。有条件的学校上完这本书以后,可在二年级开设专业英语。
- 二、本书的对话部分是教学重点,应采取听、说入手的办法,达到口头运用的目的,一般 1.5 课时完成。课文部分作为阅读课处理,不必精讲,在理解的基础上,讲练一些重点词语、句型等,可用 1.5 课时完成。课后的练习可结合对话、课文教学处理。同步练习可在课堂上完成一部分,课后学生自己处理一部分,用 1 课时完成。
- 三、本书涉及的语法大部分是巩固初中学过的知识,因此没有按语法体系编排,而是根据需要在各课练习中处理,少数新的语法现象,教师可先补充讲解,再让学生完成课后练习。
