#### 前 言

编者根据多年执教大学专科英语和从事专升本英语考 前强化辅导的教学实践,深深感到:许多考生由于没有合乎 自己需要的词汇学习参考用书,因而对词汇学习倍感困难, 掌握的词汇量不足,在应试过程中出现许多本来不该出现 的错误,从而大大影响了考试成绩。为了使他们能够拥有 一本利于学习和掌握词汇的参考用书,编者在参考了《全国 各类成人高等专科起点本科招生(非师范类)复习考试大 纲》英语词汇表和《普通高等专科英语课程教学基本要求》 词汇表的基础上编写了本书。因为两个词汇表中词汇量略 有差别,故对不同要求的词汇分别用鲜明标记列出,以便使 用者根据自己的需要去记忆和掌握必备词汇。

学习英语最使人头痛的是单词难记忆、易忘却,这将直接影响学习者的兴趣和学习积极性,从而影响学习者提高英语水平和考试成绩。为了帮助他们克服上述困难,编者特意利用了同义词帮助学习者边复习边联想,提高记忆兴趣和效率。此外,各词条所给词组搭配和用法例句力求简明、实用、生动。特别选择一些谚语用于释例中,以期培养兴趣、帮助记忆,起到事半功倍的效果。

本书编写后期正值酷暑横行之时,编写工作非常艰难。 为使本书能如期优质交稿付印,沈毛毛女士给予了很夭的 鼓舞和支持,并协助完成了一些相关的工作,在此谨表衷心的感谢。因为时间紧迫,同时编者水平、经验有限,书中不足之处在所难免,欢迎专家、读者批评指正。
