内容简介

《国家英语课程标准》的颁布被称为"我国英语的革命", 是我国今后较长时期内英语教学的指导性纲领,其中对中学 英语词汇量和阅读能力的培养也提出了更高的要求。

根据这一精神,我们编写了《中学英语美文诵读》,旨在激发学生兴趣,培养语感,帮助学生打好英语知识基础,强化提高英语阅读技能。本书有以下主要特点:

- 一、着眼中考,培养能力
- 二、题材广泛,时代感强
- 三、体例恰当,使用方便
- 四、循序渐进,梯级上升
- 五、设计新颖,知识的复现率高

英语学习并不是一件容易的事。阅读理解更是英语学习中的重点和难点。不少面临中考的同学总希望找到尽快提高成绩的方法或窍门,其实,学习英语是没有什么捷径可走的,阅读更是如此。阅读能力的培养是一个口积月累、循序渐进的过程,仅仅靠阅读教材上的文章是远远不够的,而且,新课程标准对中学生"读"的能力提出了更高的要求。为此,我们特地为中学生精心打造了《中学英语美文诵读》丛书,既可贯穿于日常学习训练之用,又可作为考试复习和备考的辅助材料。




