# 前言

词汇与结构是大学英语四级考试必考的题型。随着有关改革的深入,要在四级考试中取得高分,这部分题目的成绩的重要性日显突出。然而,在每次四级考试中,都有不少考生因为此类试题成绩不佳而功亏一篑。

实际上,许多四级词汇与结构试题并不难。由于所考的语法项目相对稳定,所考的词汇亦有一定的范围,考生只要方法得当,要在短期内通过强化训练,迅速掌握这部分知识,从而顺利通过四级考试或在四级考试中取得高分,是完全有可能的。编者认为有些考生在这类题目上失分较多,原因在于:(1)平时对词汇及语法结构的学习不够重视,语言基本功也不够扎实;(2)对此类题型命题的特点和答题技巧不甚了解。据此,编者结合多年从事大学英语教学的经验,对所收集的一些实考题目进行分类、归纳和注释,并附上所整理的四级重点词汇与结构以及15套热身自测题,汇编成了此书,希望能对考生们的四级备考有所裨益。

本书包括实考试题与精解、四级重点词汇与结构以及热身自测题三个部分。

实考试题与精解部分汇集了 1989 年 1 月至 2003 年 12 月 15 年中的 30 套,共计 900 道词汇与结构试题。题目之后的编号为该题的出处,如:9606-56 为 1996 年 6 月的考题中的第 56 题,0001-68 为 2000 年 1 月的考题中的第 68 题。考生们可以通过解题并阅读其后的注释,了解命题特点与规律、熟悉答题技巧。由于全国大学英语四级考试已历时 16 年,对多数语法知识的测试,已反复出现在这些实考试题中。考生们只要善于归纳、总结,在未来的考试中获得好成绩绝非奢望。而实考词汇试题各选项中出现的皆为高频使用词语,仍然会在今后的试题中出现,因此编者对它们也进行了较为详尽的注释。同样,词汇试题中所考查的词语重复率亦越来越高。在新近举行的两次四级考试(2003 年 12 月与 2004 年 6 月)的词汇试题中,就分别有 5 道题和 7 道题所测试的词语为以前考查过的。毋庸置疑,历年词汇与结构真题多数是专家们经深思熟虑创造的佳作,最能反映命题的意向。只要精心研究这些题目,定能知己知彼,事半功倍。

四级重点词汇与结构部分则分为常用短语介词/词组、常见介词搭配、常用短语动词、常见形似词语辨析四个部分,承上启下。它对四级考试词汇与结构部分经常涉及的一些考点,进行了系统的整理和归纳。考生们应按书中的编排进行巧记,并力求扎实掌握。因为这是学好大学英语、做好四级词汇与结构试题、通过四级考试必备的基础。

15 套热身自测题中语法结构知识和词汇的覆盖面较广,包含了编著者对近两年来此类题型命题走向的预测,与 30 套全真试题相互补充,相得益彰,是它的有机链接。希望广大考生对此给予足够的重视,并认真演练,做到举一反三、触类旁通。

解四级词汇与结构试题,一般可分两步走:(1) 先浏览题目中的四个选项、迅速判断考点;

(2) 根据题目空格前后的词语与所缺的词语或结构之间的关系来选定答案。此外,解答语法结构试题中涉及动词的题目时,应特别注意判断该动词与其逻辑主语之间的关系。解答词汇试题中涉及名词、动词或形容词等的题目时,则应重点考虑这几类词语与介词或其他类词之间的搭配。考生们无论在涉步本书中的全真试题还是热身自测题时,均可反复实践这一解题技巧。

对任何一个语种而言,词汇与结构都是它的两大支柱。很难想像一个词汇量小、对语法结构模糊不清的英语学习者,能在听、说、读、写、译等方面如鱼得水、出类拔萃。因此,编著此书的意义就不仅仅在于帮助考生在四级词汇与结构题方面出奇制胜、取得高分。它对于考生完成四级考试其他类型的题目——阅读理解、完形填空等,对于提升考生的整体英语水平,无疑都有不可估量的积极作用。

本书在编写过程中得到了福建师范大学外语学院院长陈维振教授和美国友人 Whitney 夫妇以及 Wright 先生的支持与指导;集美大学和其他一些高校的同仁也对本书的编写提出了 不少宝贵建议;我的同事钟旭樱老师更是襄助资料,提供建议,并热情参与本书部分章节的编 写工作,出力尤多。正是他们所做的这一切,使拙作能如期脱稿。在本书付梓之时,特表诚挚的谢意。
