前 音

《大学核心英语同步测训》是配合全国理工科大學使用的《大学核心英语》(College Core English,修订版,上海交通大学编写)的教学而设计编写的系列测试集。全书共分四册,与大学英语一至四级测试对应。每册各含同步卷、终结卷和水平卷三种,共10份。同步卷一至三册各6份,第四册为4份;终结卷一至三册各2份,分期中与期末卷,第四册为3份,分上、下半学期与期末卷;水平卷一至三册各2份,第四册为3份,相当于四级统考模拟试卷。

本书有两个明显的特点:一是同步,即内容紧扣《大学核心英语·读写教程》,尤其是词汇、结构、完形填空、翻译等项均针对相应课文中出现的难点与重点。每两单元设计一份同步训练测试卷;二是同级,各级的水平测试均注重学生的实际运用能力,重在表达、生成和运用,而不是单纯教会学生机械地选择辨认的应试技巧,从而加强了英语学习的基本功训练,密切了测试与教学的关系,使测试更附合国家教委颁发的《大学英语四级考试大纲》和《大学英语教学大纲》对大学英语教学与考试的要求。因此,使用本书不仅能方便教师进行分级教学,有效地检查学生在各个阶段的学习进展情况,而且能使学生事半功倍地复习每课所学内容,及时自测学习效果。

本书选材广泛,语言规范,内容丰实,循序新进,重点。难点 突出。测试卷中的各个单项均有很强的实用性和针对性。 词汇:有词类转换,选词填空,选近义词和多项选择等。同步 卷和终结卷中的关键词(组)和干扰项全部来自相应课文(A)和 (B)中的重点和难点;水平卷则反映出相应各级应予掌握的常 用词汇和短语。

结构:同步卷和终结卷的设计旨在帮助学生巩固、消化相应 课文中出现的主要语言难点;冰平卷则重点考查在各类试卷中 常见的相应级别的逐声现象。

阅读:每卷共有三至四篇短文,语言地道,可读性强,字数一般控制在 250 至 350 个,形式与统考的试卷一致。同步卷的短文内容和题材尽量与相应课文的内容配合,并注意侧重科技和科普文章的比例;终结卷和水平卷中短文的词汇和结构力求符合同级要求,凡影响理解的重要的超级词均有中文注释,但专有名词、派生词以及课文中已学过的词即使超级,在同步卷和终结卷中也一般不予注释,这样做显然有利于"迫使"学生熟悉、掌握已学的内容。

完形填空:为了配合统考,此项均为有提示选择填空,语言和词汇相对浅易,者重词汇、结构及逻辑推理的考查。

翻译:我们从第一、二册相对应的课文中精选实用的句型或词组作为提示,置于同步卷和终结卷中每句翻译题的后面,以利检查已学内容。水平卷一般不予提示。

作文:第三、四册设作文单项。作文选题广泛,体裁各异,并 附有范文,完全符合统考要求,以便学生模仿、借鉴,考出好成 绩。同步卷中不设作文,以便有更充分的时间加强生成题的训 练。

听力:各册的水平卷中均设有形式多样的听力题;各单项设置由易到难,循序渐进,最后达到大学四级考试的要求。
