Even though some of you may change your minds later, you will have to set goals and



work hard for them little by little until you graduate.

As a teacher, I always tell my students to discipline themselves, to be ready to study hard and try to be the best from the first day. Today's world is full of precious knowledge, whether it is in the arts, literature, a

profession, or a vocational skill. College is your chance of a lifetime to explore these areas.

So you should also think about taking other subjects. For a rich full life of college, you should make the most of the opportunities at hand.

I hope you have understood this by now: going to college means a lot more than getting a grade. You know you have a debt to many people. They have worked hard to make these opportunities open for you. Please, don't disappoint them! Study hard and learn more.

You should also think about this: Are you going to take a **course** to really learn something or are you going to take it only to have it on your record? I have heard far too many students tell me that they are doing a course to get a **certificate** for a better chance of "getting a job". Sadly, this is not a good **reason** to learn anything. Why? Well, firstly, you may not get a job even though you take a course that is likely to get you one. Secondly, you are cheating yourself. If you don't have a real understanding and liking of your course, you may begin to feel very unhappy. You know it will be very difficult for you to **respect** yourself unless you are proud of your work. The **truly** happy person is one who is proud of his work and honest with himself. This is true of a worker, doctor, teacher, or whatever.

So, while you begin your college life, make up your mind to learn as much as possible. From the first day in class, discipline yourself to make learning fun, not a **chore**, and to get the most from the educational opportunities open to you.


