



Flying and diving

People have always

Diving is an ancient sport. A 2,500-year-old tomb in Naples shows a man diving from a platform, possibly a cliff.

Cliff diving

All you need for cliff diving is a swimsuit, but it is very dangerous. First, you need to make sure that the water is deep enough so you will not hit rocks or other objects on the bottom. Secondly, you need to make sure you do not hurt yourself when you hit the water. Hitting water from a great height can be like hitting a wall.

There is a famous cliff diving spot in Mexico. Every day, tourists come to watch young men dive 45 metres into the ocean below.
