这是一道单项选择题,从整个句子来看,缺少的是谓语,只能从 A 和 C 两个选项中选择。本题开头给了 look 这个词,从上下文来看显然“飞”这个动作正在进行,因此本题的正确答案是 C。

考题 2 Hubei is _____ the north of Hunan.

- A. in B. on C. to D. at

这是一道介词填空的单项选择题,此题既考查了英语中表示方位的介词的使用,又考查了学生的地理知识。英语中表示方位的常用介词有 in, on, to。所说的地点如果在某一范围之内则用介词 in; 如果在某一范围之外且不接壤则用介词 to; 如果在某一范围之外并接壤就要用介词 on。从地理位置上看,湖南、湖北是相互接壤的两个省份,所以正确答案是 B。

从本题所提供的答语“Once a week”来看,应该是在问频率,所以只能选 B。

考题 4 Bob couldn't buy the dictionary because he had _____ money with him.

因为 money 是不可数名词,只能从 C 和 D 两个选项中选择。a little 表示肯定意义, little 表示否定意义,纵观全句,说的是 Bob 不能够买那本词典,显然是因为没有钱,那么正确答案就应该是 D 了。

本题考查英语表示“穿”的几个词组的用法。put on 强调“穿”的动作,后边要跟具体的衣服、鞋、帽等; dress 是“给某人穿衣服”,后边不跟具体的衣服,通常跟人; have on 意思是“穿着”“佩戴”; wear 表示状态。根据本题所表达的意思,正确答案是 B。

本题考查动词的时态,做此类题首先要抓住句子的时间状语。本句的时间状语是 in three days,这是一般将来时的时间状语,因此选 D。

这是一道词形转换题,要求用 close 的适当形式填空。动词 keep 后边可以跟形容词、动词的现在分词作宾语的补足语。本题是说做游戏时,你必须使你的眼睛保持闭合的状态,所以应该填 closed。

本题要求用所给词的正确形式填空。句中给了 in our class 这样一个比较的范围,所以应该用最高级; early 是个副词,副词的最高级前可以不加定冠词,因此本题的答案为 earliest。

这是一道句型转换题,要求将两个句



子合并为一个句子,原题给的两个句子都是否定句,那么合并后的句子也要是否定句。英语表示“两者都不”要用 neither... nor 这样的连词,而 neither... nor 连接主语时,其谓语动词要采取就近原则,即谓语动词与离它最近的主语保持一致。本题中离谓语最近的是 I, 所以第三个空应填 am。本题的答案为 Neither, nor, am。


