One way to produce more food is by growing plants. For thousands of years, farmers have made plants better, Every season, they pick the best plants for the next season. It works very slowly.

Since 1983, scientists have been able to change plants more quickly by changing their genetic material (转基因 食品), called GM foods.

If you don't know how to use the fork and knife, just watch the other people, and follow them. If you still have no idea of what to do, ask the person next to you.

If you like the food, say so. Of course, you'll thank them for the meal and for their kindness. It's also a good idea to send a thank-you card the day after.
