#### 内容提要

本书是严格按照最新高考试题 (NMET96,97)题型精心编拟的仿真训练指导书。全书共有十套仿真题以及对部分易混易错考点进行的简释,具有较强的针对性,特别适合广大高中生和高考生使用。

该书主编及编者都是具有丰富教学经验的 省重点中学把关教师。为帮助学生适应'96高 考试题调整后新题型的变化,特将此书献给广 大高中同学尤其是迎接高考的考生们。

另外,本书附有 1996,1997 年普通高等学校招生全国统一考试英语试题及答案。



### 前 言

高考复习备考既要求考生有正确的复习方法,又要求有针对性强的训练资料。只有严格按照与高考试题难度相当的仿真试题去训练,才能在复习备考中少走弯路,取得事半功倍的效果,并在高考中取得理想的成绩。鉴于此,我们组织了湖北省重点中学的部分骨干教师精心编写了这本书。

据国家考试中心对参加 1996 年高考考生英语试卷的抽样调查,1996 年普通高等学校招生全国统一考试英语试题 (NMET96)全卷的难度值为 0.55。其中,1.单项填空:0.59, I.完形填空:0.53, II.阅读理解:0.67, IV.单词拼写:0.32, V.短文改错:0.43, VI.书面表达:0.55(文、理科考生各项难度指标有 0.01~0.02 的差异)。我们在编写这本仿真试题时,力求在难度上与 NMET96 接近,在题型上完全与NMET96 一致,以利考生熟悉高考试题题型,把握高考试题难度,以期达到"熟能通其容,糟能尽其妙"的境界。

本书共分两个部分:

第一部分为十套高考仿真训练试题。训练题以 NMET96, 97 难度为标高,以教材课本为依据,以教学大纲和考试说明为 指导,精心选题;注重知识的覆盖面和考点的多样性和灵活性, 力求使考生们通过训练,提高分析问题、解决问题、熟练运用英 语的能力。

每套训练題分第一卷(选择題)和第二卷(非选择題)两部分。全套題共计150分。读者做每套題时,可控制在120分钟內, 以模拟高考考试时间要求。

第二部分为参考答案及重要考点简释。主要是给考生提供 自测、自评、自我提高的依据,并通过简释,帮助考生扫除高考备 考复习过程中出现的易混易错的知识盲点,提高自学能力和应 试水平,以达到编者所期望的"一书在手,高考不愁"的效果。

书后附有 NMET96,97 试题和答案,供广大读者了解和熟 悉高考试题。

愿此书成为广大中学生尤其是高三考生的良师益友。

本书编写得到华中理工大学出版社鼎力支持,王金芳老师打印了全部稿件,在此一并感谢。

由于编者水平有限,书中定有疏漏,敬请读者批评指正。
