第一章 2006 年 MBA 联考试卷分析

1. 词汇

在 2006 年 MBA 联考试卷的词汇考题中，有 8 道题考查搭配，5 道题考查近义词，4 道题考查形近词，3 道题考查短语。这说明，2006 年 MBA 联考试卷词汇题考查的重点是搭配与近义词，同时还考查形近词和短语。因此，学员在平时的复习中应该注重这些方面的训练。

2. 完形填空

2006 年 MBA 联考试卷的完形填空题是一篇经济题材的文章。有 3 道题考查近义词，4 道题考查搭配，7 道题考查引导词和介词，其他 6 道题考查为分词和时态等。这说明，2006 年 MBA 联考试卷完形填空题考查的重点是语法知识，以引导词和介词为主。因此，学员在平时的复习中应该注重这些方面的练习。

3. 阅读理解

2006 年 MBA 联考试卷的阅读文章有 2 篇人文题材的文章，1 篇经济题材的文章，1 篇教育题材的文章。20 道题目中，有 9 道细节题，3 道主旨题，2 道推论题，2 道词义题，2 道态度题，2 道结构题。这说明，2006 年 MBA 联考试卷阅读题考查的重点仍然是细节题，但是主旨题、态度题和结构题的比重增大。因此，学员在平时的复习中应该注重细节题、主旨题、态度题和结构题的训练，同时兼顾推论题和词义题。

4. 翻译

2006 年 MBA 联考试卷的翻译题是一篇科技题材的文章。5 句话中，有 4 句话考查宾语从句、定语从句、状语从句以及插入语，1 句话考查分词。这说明，2006 年 MBA 联考试卷翻译题考查的重点仍然是从句。因此，学员在平时的复习中应该注重从句的翻译，同时兼顾非谓语结构。

5. 写作

2006 年 MBA 联考试卷的作文题要求根据一个图表作文。这类文章的第一段一般应该说明图表反映的信息（变化），中间段落分析造成变化的原因，最后段落应该提出预测或应对的办法。

纵观 2006 年 MBA 联考英语试卷，我们可以得出这样的结论——考试的难度在逐渐加大，对考生的要求在逐渐提高。因此，在下面的章节里，我们将帮助考生掌握应付各种题型的技巧，各个击破，真正做到有备无患。

第二章 词 汇

MBA 英语联考词汇题考查的重点有以下几个方面：

1. 动词

例如：Don't _____ this news to the public until we give you the go-ahead.

- A. release B. relieve C. relate D. retain

应选 A。release 意为“宣布”，指准许公开；relieve 意为“减轻”，指导致……的减轻或缓和；relate 意为“讲述”，指有条理地陈述出某情况；retain 意为“保留”，指保持或维持在一个特殊的场所、条件或位置。根据题目的意思，结合选项可知，应选 A。

2. 名词

例如：I can't advise you what to do next; you must use your own _____.

- A. opinion B. thought C. judgment D. idea

应选 C。opinion 意为“意见，看法”，指对事物或问题经过思索后形成的意见、主张或看法；thought 意为“想法”，指经过沉思、推理而在头脑中形成的意念或思想；judgment 意为“判断，看法”，指在考虑或商议之后形成的某个观点；idea 意为“观点，主意”，指由于理解、思索、推理、幻想而产生于脑中的思想、念头、主意或想法。根据题目的意思，结合选项可知，应选 C。

3. 形容词与副词

例如：I shall have a companion in the house after all these _____ years.

- A. single B. sole C. alone D. lonely

应选 D。single 意为“单个的”，指没有另一个人或其他人陪伴的；sole 意为“惟一的”，指只有单独一个或少数几个的；alone 意为“孤单的”，指离开他人的，通常作表语；lonely 意为“孤独的”，指以独自一人作为特征的。根据题目的意思，结合选项可知，应选 D。

4. 商务词汇

例如：The _____ thus incurred will be payable by the ship, freight, and cargo in proportion to their respective value.

- A. investment B. consumption C. expenditure D. cost

应选 C。investment 意为“投资”，指拨出钱或资金以获得金钱上的回报；consumption 意为“消费”，指为直接使用或拥有而购买商品或服务；expenditure 意为“花费”，指为达到目的或完成目标而支付的费用；cost 意为“成本”，指为达到某一目的而必需的代价。根据题目的意思，结合选项可知，应选 C。

5. 介词

例如：These are the first steps _____ the abolition of nuclear weapons.

- A. of B. towards C. into D. during

应选 B。step 通常与 to 或 towards 搭配，意为“迈向……的一步”；其他三个介词搭配

不对。
