TOEFL Junior 考试由美国教育考试服务中心(ETS)研发推广,是"托福"家族新成员。TOEFL Junior 考试是面向英语为非母语国家的 11-15 岁中学生的国际标准化语言测评,它不仅可以提供语言成绩帮助考生申请美国中学,也可以成为考生进一步学习英语的指南。自 2010 年 TOEFL Junior 考试开始推广以来,已经有越来越多的美国中学了解和认可这项考试,并接受其成绩作为人学语言成绩。

TOEFL Junior 考试于 2011 年 10 月正式进入中国,国内报考人数日益增多,考生对于考试相关信息和资料的需求亟待满足。我们以《TOEFL Junior 考试官方指南》为指导,以北美优秀教辅书为参考,结合考生参加历次考试的反馈和教师的授课、教研经验编写了这套 TOEFL Junior 练习题,包括《TOEFL Junior 词汇精讲精练》、《TOEFL Junior 语言形式与含义》、《TOEFL Junior 听力》及《TOEFL Junior 阅读》。作为国内最早的 TOEFL Junior 备考辅导书籍,这套练习具有相当的权威性和实用性,适合参加 TOEFL Junior 考试的所有考生使用。

本书为 TOEFL Junior 词汇练习,可以配合《TOEFL Junior 词汇精选》使用。编写的目的是为了帮助考生快速有效地记忆单词,使考生能在不同的语境中认知单词,并准确把握考试中的词汇考

点。本书编写时遵循了如下原则:

- 1. **情境记忆**:每个单元的 10 道题目衔接起来都是一篇文章,所有词汇练习都围绕文章为中心进行设计,做到词不离句,句不离段,段不离文。
- 2. **联想记忆**:每个单元的记忆词汇将中心词、近义词、反义词以及扩展词联为一组记忆。
- 3. 分类训练:每个单元的词汇练习包括三类试题形式。第一类为 主观题,答案选项词汇多为记忆联想词汇列表中的同义词、近 义词、反义词及扩展词,主要考查考生对于单词含义的记忆; 第二类为客观题,设置这类题目是为了引导考生掌握词汇的语 言形式和意义;第三类为开放试题,主要提升考生对新词的猜 测和判断能力。
- 4. 内容选择:阅读文章是根据《TOEFL Junior 词汇精选》中的 2000 余个词汇来取材的。文章共50篇,题材包括科普、社会、文化、政治、经济等;体裁包括记叙文、说明文、应用文等。

最后,非常感谢关心和支持本书出版的新东方大愚文化传播 有限公司和本书的教研团队,是他们的努力使本书得以顺利出版。

祝愿所有考生在本书的帮助下都能够顺利通过 TOEFL Junior 考试。


