Grizzly means **grey**.






Brown (or grizzly) bears are strong heavy animals with thick **fur**.

Some are red-brown, and some are very dark brown.

Bears have very long noses, and they can smell everything.



Bear **tracks** show that bears have five toes, with claws.

Brown bears live in cool forests near rivers and grassy places.

They need large spaces to hunt in, because they eat so much food.

How bears catch fish


Brown bears love to eat fish.

They catch fish with their mouths or their paws.

Bears eat all day long



Bears eat new grass, leaves, berries, flowers, nuts, seeds and mushrooms; fish, insects, mice and ground squirrels. They take honey from wild bees, and eggs from birds' nests.

When the first autumn snow comes, most bears are still eating.

Bears love eating berries in the autumn.

They need to grow fat before winter comes.

Do bears eat insects?

Bears in the winter

In the winter, brown bears don't eat. They stay asleep all winter long. This is called **hibernating**. Brown bears and black bears hibernate in cold winters.

Sometimes they make their own **dens**, as this black bear has done.



Bears dig their dens under trees, or in banks, with their strong claws.

Yes. Bears eat insects.

Bear cubs

Bear cubs are born in the den in the middle of winter.

The mother bear has two or three cubs at once.

The tiny cubs drink their mother's milk and grow fast.

In spring they are big enough to follow their mother outside.




The mother bear is thin and hungry in the spring, and she needs to eat nearly all the time.

The cubs love to play but they keep near their mother, and they come back to her when they want to feed.

The cubs keep growing, and soon they want to try all sorts of food. Their mother shows them what to eat and where to find it. When they are three years old, they will leave their mother and take care of themselves.

Bears hibernate in cold winters.
