You try to hit the man but the man hits you first.


■ Go to 24.

- You go to the Stones of Clayonag. Go to 20.






You drive slowly down the hill. Ten minutes later you look behind you. You cannot see the red car.

■ Go to 34.




- You go to the village and you ask some people about the megalithic stones. Nobody wants to talk about them.

■ Go to 24.


You go into the tomb. You see some pictures of knives on the wall. You hear a noise. Everything goes dark. You go to the door. You cannot open it.


'Thank you,' you say. You go into your house.

■ Go to 21.



'No,' you say, 'I'm an archaeologist. I want to study the megalithic stones on the island.'


'How interesting! I don't know anything about those things,' she says.
