

内容简介

本书严格按照教育部高等教育司 2007 年颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求》中的四级词汇表编写。本书基于二十多年来的大学英语四级考试真题,准确标注每个单词的出现频率,重点明确。在词义的注释上,参考相关书籍及近年考试真题,具有科学性和针对性,利于考生对词汇进行系统复习,有效提高应试能力。为便于理解词义,词条释义配以典型例句和真题原文,并注明部分重点词条的搭配及派生词,帮助考生在轻松掌握其用法的同时记忆多个词汇,起到事半功倍的效果。此外,每个单词都标有英式和美式两种音标,便于考生朗读使用,利于听说能力的提高。

本书适用于在校大学生和准备参加大学英语四级考试的考生。

第 2 版前言 PREFACE TO THE SECOND EDITION

第1版的《大学英语四级大纲词汇详解》是根据教育部高等教育司2007年最新颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求》中四级词汇表的新词条、新释义、新短语编写而成的。自2013年12月考次起,全国大学英语四级考试委员会对四级考试的试卷结构和测试题型已作局部调整。为了更加切合广大读者的实际需求,本书编者在秉承和发扬原书的编纂风格和特色的基础上,对该书进行了全面系统的修订,推出了这本全新的《大学英语四级大纲词汇详解》(第2版)。

此次修订仍然沿用第1版的框架,更正了第1版中出现的一些单词拼写、音标标注等错误,并调整了其中格式上的不适宜之处;另外,在词性、释义、搭配以及示例等方面对原词条进行了相应的补充和更新,使其内容更加丰富、全面和实用,使本书更加适合作为准备四级考试的学生的参考用书。

由于编者学养有限, 便短汲深, 纰漏讹误之处势所难免, 恳请读者及同行不吝赐教并给予我们批评与建议, 以便使本书更加完善。

本书根据教育部高等教育司 2007 年最新颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求》中的新词条、新释义、新短语编写而成。

相比于其他词汇书,本书具有如下特色:

- 1. 标注单词在二十多年来考试真题中考查的频次,使考生做到有的放矢;
- 2. 音标方面突出英美发音差异,提高考生听说能力;
- 3. 收录与单词相关的常考搭配,满足考生在听力、写作等板块的应用需求;
- 4. 示例具有很强的代表性,强调在语境中记忆词汇的重要性;
- 5. 真实重现二十多年来的真题原句,把握考试动态;
- 6. 增加派生词,实现词汇的纵向延伸。

为方便读者学习,本书末尾附有常用词缀以及不规则动词。

总而言之,本书会帮助读者在短时间内实现词汇量的突破与质的飞跃。

由于编者水平有限,疏漏之处在所难免,尚祈专家及广大读者不吝指正。
