We have all seen and heard the advertisements: "Got Milk?" and "Milk: It Does a Body Good." As children, we are taught that milk has calcium and that drinking milk is good for building strong bones and teeth. This idea has become so deeply-rooted in society that it is now like a sacred cow in India. But is all that we have been taught about milk true? Is milk the best source of calcium? The answer is both "yes" and "no".

The calcium in milk does in fact build strong bones by increasing what is known as "bone mineral density". Increasing bone mineral density is necessary when the bones are still growing. That's why most doctors advise children to drink a lot of milk. But too much of a good thing may not be all that good. Some doctors now believe that drinking too much milk is actually unhealthy. They claim that the animal protein in milk may have a negative impact on our health.

Some research suggests that the animal protein in milk may actually increase the rate at which our bodies lose calcium. Diets high in animal protein increase the amount of acid in the body. In order to keep a healthy acid balance, the bones release calcium. Therefore, drinking too much milk can result in a loss of calcium from our bones instead.

Even though most doctors still believe milk is good for us, some people are turning to other foods to get calcium.
Fortunately, calcium is present in many kinds of food. Two of the best alternative sources of calcium are tofu and soy milk.
One cup of either of these has almost as much calcium as a cup of milk, but has much less animal protein. Green leafy
vegetables, like broccoli and Chinese cabbage, are also calcium rich. With these great alternatives to milk, one might ever
say it is time to put that old sacred cow out to pasture. 4265

Back to the motherland

People are not the only animals who dream of going back to the land of their ancestors. Certain kinds of fish and birds travel thousands of miles to their homelands in order to give birth. Giant panda Binbin became the latest animal to make this special journey when he came to China from Japan last week.

Binbin was one of the 23 pandas living outside China. His parents, Meimei and Yongming, were leased by China to the Adventure World Park Zoo in Japan in 1994 and 2000 respectively. Their baby "boy" weighed just 190 grams when he was born in December 2001, but he has now grown to 88.6 kilograms.

Pandas have existed since the dinosaur time. They are now listed among the world's most endangered wildlife species and are close to being extinct. Their habitat is under threat while their food, a special type of wild bamboo leaf, is rare. Groups of pandas also live far from each other, making it hard for them to breed.

China has been working very hard to stop the animals dying out. These efforts have seen panda numbers in China rise by 40 percent to 1,590 since the 1980s.

China has also carried out a series of panda research and breeding programmes with other countries. "Binbin is a successful example of such co-operations," said Yu Jianqiu, of the Giant Panda Breeding and Research Centre in Chengdu, where Binbin is now based. So far the two sides have successfully bred four pandas in Japan.

Binbin was the first male giant panda born in a foreign land to return to China this year. In February, Huamei, a female panda born in the US, also came back.

Pandas are not only seen as Chinese "national treasures", but also very popular overseas. Binbin was a hit in Japan, while Meixiang and Tiantian, who are based at the National Zoo in Washington, US, are also a big attraction.
