前 言

学好英语需要大量阅读,要提高阅读能力更需要积累大量词汇与语法知识。为了能有效提高学生的英语阅读水平,帮助学生积累语言材料,丰富语言知识,增强语言感悟能力,进一步提高应试技能,我们组织资深教师和命题专家编写了这套初中实验班英语专项训练丛书,其中包括《实验班英语专项通 阅读理解》(七年级、八年级、九年级)、《实验班英语专项通 词汇与语法》(初中),共七册。

丛书的编写不完全拘泥于各种版本的初中英语教材,而是在充分理解新大纲,吃透新课标的基础上,结合现今初中英语教学的实际,以及考虑到优等生的培养目标与具体的实施方法,精心设计的。

丛书按照循序渐进的原则,以教科书基本要求为起点,由易到难,层层深入,逐步上升到中考、重点高中自主招生的高度。

丛书具有以下特色:

- 1. 源于基础。丛书紧扣大纲,贴近教材,选题典型,层次分明,且把握一定的区分度。
- 2. 注重能力。丛书知识覆盖面宽,突出处理教学中的重点与难点,同时向学生提供了大量与中考及重点高中自主招生题型相同的练习,通过这些题型的系统训练,学生英语阅读的综合能力将会有较大突破。
- 3. 内容新颖。丛书所选文章具有较强的时代气息和阅读趣味,题材多样,有时事新闻报道、政治经济、日常生活、科技小品、名人轶事等。
