A Greek man is suing a dairy in Sweden for 50 million kronor (\$6.9m; £4.5m) for using his image on pots of Turkish-style yoghurt, Swedish media report.

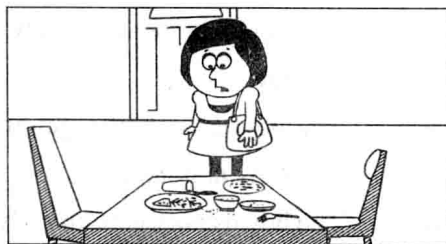

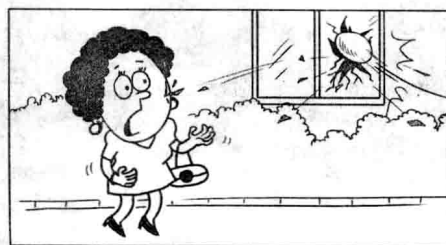

Slavery has existed for thousands of years and it still exists in some parts of the world. But the worst period of slavery in modern history was from the 1500s to the 1880s. Millions of Africans were taken by the English, and also by the Spanish, Portuguese and French, to the new colonies in North and South America and the Caribbean.

Thousands of people died during the journey across the Atlantic because of the terrible conditions on the ships. Those who survived were sold at markets. Families were often separated forever. The slaves worked on the plantations that grew tobacco, rice, sugar and cotton, and in the homes of the plantation owners.

Life was extremely hard and many slaves tried to escape. If they were caught, they were cruelly punished.

One of the first strong voices against slavery belonged to a slave called Olaudah Equiano. He wrote a book about their suffering. Later, another book, *Tom's Cabin* by Harriet Beecher Stowe also helped to change public opinion. In 1787 the Abolition Society was formed in Britain, but 20 years passed before the British slave trade was stopped. Slavery continued in the USA for many years after that, mainly in the southern states.

In the northern states, the campaign to abolish slavery became stronger and from 1861 to 1865 there was a Civil War between the northern states and the southern states. The North won. Then all the slaves were freed but, in fact, they had fewer rights than white people. It was not until 1960s that campaigners such as Martin Luther King began the Civil Rights Movement, and finally all blacks were given equal rights in education, jobs and voting.

Today, as in every other day of the year, more than 3,000 US adolescents will smoke their first cigarette on their way to becoming regular smokers as adults. During their lifetime, it can be expected that of these 3,000 about 23 will be murdered, 30 will die in traffic accidents, and nearly 750 will be killed by a smoking-related disease. The number of deaths attributed to cigarette smoking outweighs all other factors, whether voluntary or involuntary, as a cause of death.



Since the late 1970s, when daily smoking among high school seniors reached 30 percent, smoking rates among youth have declined. While the decline is impressive, several important issues must be raised.

First, in the past several years, smoking rates among youth have declined very little. Second, in the late 1970s, smoking among male high school seniors exceeded that among female by nearly 10 percent. The statistic is reversing. Third, several recent studies have indicated that high school dropouts have excessively high smoking rates, as much as 75 percent.

Finally, though significant declines in adolescent smoking have occurred in the past decade, no definite reasons for the decline exist. Within this context, the National Cancer Institute (NCI) began its current effort to determine the most effective measures to reduce smoking levels among youth.
