内 容 提 要

本书共有阅读材料 60 篇,按能力层次分为识记、理解、应用三部分。内容健康,语言风趣,难易适中,有一定的可读性。每篇都编有五道标准化的“选择题”或“正误辨认题”,便于教师组织学生进行阅读训练,有较大的实用价值。

编者的话

在中学英语教学中,阅读具有非常重要的意义和作用,它不仅是中学英语教学的主要目标,而且是培养学生自学能力的重要手段。初中学生,已经具有了拼读单词的能力,掌握了一定数量的词汇和一些简单的语法知识,具备了阅读的基本条件。因此,适当地给他们增加一些课外阅读材料,无疑会激发学生的学习兴趣,增加语言材料的复现,使学生在阅读这一语言实践中逐步学会略读、寻读、猜测词义、揣摩句意等阅读技巧,提高阅读速度与理解水平。本书的编写就是本着上述目的,分识记、理解、应用三个能力层次帮助学生逐步提高阅读能力。

本书共 60 篇阅读材料,都是从书报杂志上精选的童话、故事或短文,内容健康有益,语言风趣幽默,难易程度适中。为适合初中学生的程度,有些地方进行了改写。每篇长度一般在 150~300 个词之内,生词率不超过 2%,对一些初中学生未学

过的单词和习语做了注释,并编有标准化的“选择题”或“正误辨认题”,便于读后检查阅读效果,书末附有练习参考答案。

本书供初二、初三学生或相当于这一水平的自学者使用。

此外,建议读者在使用本书时,注意以下几点:

1、专心致志地一气读完一篇短文。读完后,立即做后面的练习;必要时,可进行第二遍搜索性阅读(寻读)。如答对的题数达到总题数70%以上,可视为基本达到要求。

2、努力学会猜测词义的方法。阅读时,遇到某些生词不要随意放弃,也不要停留在某个生词上反复思考、推敲,应从整句、整段或整篇文章着眼,根据上下文或词形猜出它的意思。

由于编者水平所限,编写时间匆促,本书难免存在缺点和错误,祈望读者批评指正。
