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

前言

专四考试中,听力部分的分值占30%,听力能力的高低很大程度上影响着考生考试成绩的好坏。如何科学安排复习、快速提高听力水平是所有考生必须面对和思考的问题。

通过总结多年的一线教学和阅卷经验以及对考生的多次问卷调查统计,本 书作者发现,考生听力能力低下、听力分数不高主要有以下几方面原因:

一、复习欠缺规划

听力能力的提高不是一蹴而就的,需要科学的计划和安排,但很多考生的听力复习都是三天打鱼、两天晒网,没有系统、没有计划,导致复习效率低下。

二、基础掌握不牢

听力的场景话题不够熟悉、词汇句式基础不牢是很多考生提高听力水平 的瓶颈,缺乏基本的听音基础,做再多的练习,花再多的时间,复习效果都 不会明显。

三、技巧运用不当

很多考生以为听力水平的提高就是依靠长时间的练习,只要多花时间、 多听就行了,谈不上什么技巧。其实,不同的听力题型有不同的做题技巧, 做题时有针对性地使用这些技巧,养成良好的听音习惯,可以让你的学习事 半功倍,更可以让你在考场上从容应对。

四、练习不够充分

纸上谈兵,听力水平是不可能提高的,光是基础好、会技巧,没有足够的练习,也发挥不了多大的作用。多听,多练,才能切实提高听力水平。

我们的对策

我们从专四听力的题型特点和设题规律出发,针对考生复习中经常出现

的问题,精心编写了这本书。本书内容安排在5周进行,每周5天,共25天。第1至4周每周1个听力题型,分项学习,各个击破;第5周模拟自测,实战演练,全面提升。

具体来讲,本书有以下特色:

一、5周时间,规划科学

第1至4周每周1个题型:第1周短文听写、第2周对话理解、第3周短文理解、第4周新闻理解;每周一到周四每天一项任务,带你扎实基础、掌握技巧、边学边练,每周五复习效果检验,让你通过自我测试检验一周复习的成效。第5周精心设计了6套模拟自测,带你在实践中检验自我、巩固提高。5周的安排,目标明确,科学合理,帮助考生理清复习思路,快速提升听力水平。

二、典型自测, 自我诊断

在进入具体讲解之前,先给出1套典型的听力试题,在解析中对题目的解题技巧、错误原因给出详尽的点评分析,并给考生提出合理的复习建议,让考生通过模拟自测,找出自己的弱点,明确听力的努力方向。

三、考点精练, 讲解到位

针对各种题型,透析考查重点,提炼必备知识,点拨解题技巧,将每个 题型涉及的考点、知识、技巧分成若干个模块,安排在每天里进行透彻讲解,实现各个击破。

四、充分练习, 练透练精

每天的讲解都配有专题演练,每周复习结束时都配有各题型的模拟题, 检验一周的复习效果,让考生学完一个,练透一个,彻底吃透所学的知识。 最后还配有6套听力模拟试题,让考生真正练透练精。

五、对照解析, 清楚明了

本书的解析点评采用了分栏对照的形式,让考生清楚直观地看出问题和 题眼的对应关系,方便考生学习理解,提高复习效率。

一、专四听力命题方向

听力理解能力一直是专业四级考试测试的重点和难点,其分值所占比例高达30%,听力能力的高低将直接影响到考生考试成绩的好坏,因此,在短期内熟悉听力考点、掌握解题技巧,最终提高听力能力、获得高分,已经成为考生越来越迫切的需要。

专四听力考试时间为 35 分钟, 所占分值为 30 分, 共包括两大部分: 第一部分为短文听写(DICTATION), 第二部分为听力理解(LISTENING COMPREHENSION), 该部分又包括对话、短文和新闻三种题型。各题型的出题形式及所占分值如下:
