前 言

BFT 英文全称为 Business Foreign Language Test,即全国出国培训备选人员外语考试。BFT 是由国家外国专家局主办的国家级标准化外语水平测试,是衡量出国培训人员外语水平的国家级标准。该考试适用于我国政府、工商企业、财政金融等部门出国培训人员,已在或准备到国内外资企业工作的各类英语学习者,及参加中、高级专业技术资格评定的各类专业技术人员。BFT 英语考试每年 3 次,分为初级(C 级)、中级(B 级)和高级(A 级)3 个级别,包括听力 50 分、阅读 70 分、写作 30 分、口语 50 分。

现在外语水平考试很多,像托福、雅思及英语四、六级等,而每一项外语水平考试因为目的不同,对考生水平要求也不同。因此,到目前为止,还没有任何一种外语证书可以替代 BFT 考试。本着从读者的实际需要出发,为了节省考生的时间与精力、提高学习效率,我们精准把握考试大纲对词汇短语的要求,突出词汇短语的记忆和应用技巧,编写了《BFT 词汇速成胜经(初级)》这本书。

本书具有以下几个特色:

1. 紧扣大纲,精心编写

本书紧扣教材和考试大纲,并根据作者多年来的教学实践经验精心编写而成。

2. 短语搭配,加深理解

本书提供了大量重要的短语搭配,这些短语搭配都是考试中经常出现的,掌握好这些短语不仅可以帮助考生更好地掌握词汇的用法,还可以提高考生的应试技巧。

3. 例句用法,注重应用

本书提供了经典例句和用法,让考生在语境中加深对词汇的印象以及

对词义的进一步理解与把握。真实的语境可以激发学习者的兴趣,使学习单词达到事半功倍的效果。

4. 经典谚语,扩充知识

本书提供了与某些词汇相关的谚语,有趣的谚语可以给学习者留下深刻的印象,使学习者在轻松和愉快的学习中掌握更多的知识,同时使考生在平时的学习中就注意储备丰富的语言材料,更好应对考试。

由于编者水平有限,加之时间仓促,书中错误和疏漏之处在所难免,敬请广大读者朋友批评指正。
