





What budgies look like


These birds are wild budgies.
They are green, with yellow heads.
They have black spots
on their necks.



Some pet budgies are green, too.
They look like wild budgies.
Other pet budgies are blue,
or yellow or white.



Are wild budgies green and yellow?



Yes. Wild budgies are green and yellow.


A budgie has two eyes and a **beak**. It has two feet with claws. It has two wings and a long tail and it has feathers to keep it warm. Budgies have ears, but you cannot see them. They are hidden under their feathers.

Budgies' beaks

Budgies' beaks help them to open **seeds**.

Pet budgies climb around inside their **cages**. Their beaks help them. Budgies climb with their beaks and with their feet.

Yes. Budgies have ears.
They are hidden under their feathers.




Budgies' food

and carrot and **lettuce** and they like


green dandelion leaves.

Tame budgies and water



This budgie flies to the **sink** when the water is running. He likes playing in the water.



Hen birds and cock birds

Mother budgies are called hen budgies.

Father budgies are called cock budgies.

A cock budgie has a blue **patch** above its beak.
A hen budgie has a brown patch.

Yes. Budgies do eat seeds.

Nests, eggs and baby birds

All baby birds come from eggs.

Wild budgies lay their eggs in holes in trees.

They do not make **nests**.

Pet budgies lay their eggs in a nesting box.



This hen budgie is inside her nesting box. She is sitting on her eggs to keep them warm.



Mother budgies are called hen budgies.

Baby budgies
come from the eggs.
They are **bare**with no feathers.
They will grow feathers
when they are bigger.



When the baby budgies have their new feathers they come out of their box. Then they try to fly. Soon they can fly all around their cage. Young budgies have short tails.

They sit on their eggs to keep them warm.
