词汇在各种标准化测试中都起着举足轻重的作用,按照常规,一般 是先背单词后做题,而本书却另辟蹊径:通过大量自主测试题培养学生 边练边背单词的能力。其宗旨是开辟出英语词汇学习的新模式,帮助学 生摆脱死记硬背的烦恼,力求每一次测试的过程都能产生一次新的记 忆,利用较短的时间达到大学英语课程教学要求推荐的词汇量,在全国 大学英语四级考试中获得佳绩。

大学英语课程一般要求推荐的词汇量为4 795个(含中学应掌握的 词汇)。本书删除新课标初、高中英语词汇后,根据词频和分级数据, 运用美国哥伦比亚大学师范学院爱德华·李·桑戴克(Edward Lee Thorndike, 1874—1949)所著《教师词书》(The Teacher's Word Book) 和"英国国家语料库" (British National Corpus, 简称BNC) 高频词 表,以及编者主持的语料库科研项目"大学英语教学与自主学习语料 库"(包含大学英语多功能词库、大学英语四六级词库、英汉双解词 库. 共收录80 000多词条. 拥有在线查找功能、登陆使用功能、自主学 习系统屏幕查词功能、升级录入及子词库功能)的语料资源、某国家级 试题库分级词表和上海科学普及出版社出版的《精选·分级大学英语词 汇手册》,将教学经验与词频统计相结合,以全新的理念为指导,选定 收录最佳词条。通过分频、分级统计、精选出1760个大学英语四级考试 词汇,对这些单词逐个地进行科学的测试。所测试的单词从简到难,从 最常用的高频词开始,按照循序渐进的规律分频测试,测试题分为10个 单元,每个单元包括5个章节,共50章,每个单元有176道题,分布在高 频复记词、高频易记词、中频狂记词、低频速记词、低频硬记词练习 中。

在习题设计上,本书参考了上海外语教育出版社原版引进的美国

Townsend Press出版的英语词汇学习丛书Building Vocabulary Skills。练习设计形式多样,注重实用性,开发出7种题型,包括搭配练习、多项选择题、汉译英完成句子、选词完成句子、完形填空、双空选择题和英译汉。从单词、句子、段落到篇章,从纯正英语到英汉双语,进行多方位训练,培养学生的实战能力。通过大量的、多类型的训练,帮助学生复习、推测或猜测词义,在语境中学习生词,从而达到理解、巩固、掌握并最终自然而然地记忆单词之目的。在整个过程中,学生是积极主动的参与者,而不是被动的记忆者。

习题语料大多来源于网络中地道的句子、段落和文章,有些经过改编,但不失原文的风格,具有时代性和趣味性。

选择题以方框内或选项内提供的词形变化为准,解析中部分单词还原成原形,以便直观地说明词类。本书所有练习均有答案与解析,编入附录中,便于查找。

本书可单独使用,也可与《大学英语四级核心词汇》配套使用,单元和章节数量与其相同,练习的词汇选自收录的词条。有这两本书在手,学生可以根据自己的学习习惯和需求进行选择:可先使用本书,再利用《大学英语四级核心词汇》扩充词汇量,学前推测、例句、巧记、词缀、词根、词组、典型例句、用法、词汇辨析、辨析测试、同义词、反义词诸多板块会使人产生一书在手,如览群书之感。也可先使用《大学英语四级核心词汇》,再利用本书巩固或测试自己的词汇知识。通过测试,找出自己没掌握好的单词,进一步学习,重点突破。在练习后记忆或记忆后再练习,多一次相遇就可能让某个词成为永久的记忆。
