This book contains thirty-nine important articles and speeches by Comrade Deng Xiaoping, written or delivered between 1938 and 1965, most of which are published here for the first time.

Included are Comrade Deng Xiaoping's main writings and speeches before the "cultural revolution", reflecting his contributions in the fields of military and political affairs, economic development and Party building during the historical periods of the War of Resistance Against Japan, the War of Liberation, and the seventeen years after the founding of the People's Republic of China. As a component of Mao Zedong Thought, his views and theories will be of great significance to the study of the Party's history; his creative views, in particular, will serve as valuable guidance for the ongoing socialist construction and reform in China.

In compiling this book, the editors have made a few changes in language and corrected errors of fact. Records of speeches have been edited. All writings in the book have been examined and approved by the author.
