前 言

为配合广大高中生迎接高考,系统地学习和掌握英语语法,根据教育部颁布的《中学英语教学大纲》、《全日制高级中学英语教科书》以及近几年全国各地高考英语试卷,我们精心编写了这本《新课标高中英语语法与词汇 1000 题》。

本书由 10 套题综合训练组成,每套训练没有 100 道题目, 共计 1000 道测试题。其中前八套综合训练主要针对中学阶级 的语法知识点设置,后两套综合训练集中训练高中词汇的用法 及辨析。在编写这 1000 题试题的过程中,我们不仅注意题目所 涵盖的语法基础知识,同时还特别强调各个语法项目中的重点 和难点,因为这些往往是考试中经常考查的。此外,本书针对所 有的题目都给出了详细的答案解析。


