・前音・

根据国家教委制定的中学英语教学大纲,高中阶段的英语教学应注重培养学生的阅读理解能力;历年高考对阅读理解能力的测验也都占有较大的比例。

为帮助广大英语爱好者及中学生在短时间内提高英语阅读能力,我们编写了《英语阅读基本技巧训练》一书,旨在通过科学、系统的训练,帮助学生们掌握一定的阅读技巧,从而提高阅读理解能力;与此同时,帮助学生们不断扩大词汇量,丰富知识,增强语感。

本书内容新颖,题材广泛,课文内容涉及自然科学、社会科学及人文科学的十几个领域,诸如:地理、历史、经济、数学、生物、人物传记、风土人情等;语言科学规范,反映了英语特有的表达方法,习惯用法,思维习惯以及社会文化背景,融科学性、知识性、和趣味性于一体,有利于引导学生有计划、有步骤地进行提高阅读能力的训练。

全书共分三部分:

第一部分为阅读技巧训练,包括:

①根据上下文推断词义(Using the Context):本部分的训练目的在于通过阅读使学生学会从部分到整体,从整体到部分的思考方法。例如,有些题的答案虽符合某一句话的意思,但与整段话的意思不符,因此需要扩大思考范围,全盘考虑后再确定答案。在做题过程中,首先通读全句,然后利用同义词、同义短语、近义词、甚至反

义词来推断生词的含义。

- ②掌握文章中心(Getting the Main Idea):本部分的训练目的在于培养学生归纳总结段意,理解全文主旨大意的能力。
- ③判断推理(Drawing Conclusions):本部分的训练目的在于帮助学生理解文章词汇以外的暗含意思,其中包括事件的因果关系,人物的目的、动机,作者的态度、倾向等,培养学生的推理、判断能力。

第二部分为篇幅较短的课文,配有习题,目的在于对 第一部分涉及的基本技巧进行综合训练。

第三部分为阅读课文与练习,用于帮助学生们提高 并检查自己阅读能力的发展。课文的难度逐渐增加,习题 的形式与难度同高考阅读理解题接轨。

本书根据循序渐进的原则由浅入深,由易到难编排。 文中出现的生词(中学英语教学大纲要求以外的词汇) 部分给出中文意思;凡可通过上下文推断出词义的生词, 以及不影响理解全文意思的生词都没有给出中文词义, 目的在于鼓励学生自觉培养通过上下文猜测词义的能力。

本书在编写与审定过程中,北京实验中学、北京师范 大学第二附属中学以及北京师范大学外语系的教师给予 了大力支持,并提出了宝贵的意见,在此表示由衷的感 谢。
