为配合广大初中学生迎接中考,全面系统地熟悉和掌握初中阶段英语各项基本技能,根据教育部颁布的《中学英语教学大纲》、《初中英语词汇总表》、《全日制初级中学英语教科书》以及近几年全国部分地区的中考英语试卷,我们在《初中英语完形填空、首字母填空 2000 题》的基础上,精心编写了本书。“完形填空”、“首字母填空”这两个项目已经逐渐成为全国很多地区中考英语中的必考项目,越来越受到广大考生的重视。这种考试形式是对学生英语语言综合能力的一种测评,学生首先要在阅读理解的基础上才能根据选项完成题目,而在做判断的时候还要考虑到时态、语态等多种语法因素,同时还要注意用词的得当。因此,它既能考查学生的语言知识水平,又能检测他们分析判断和综合运用语言的能力。“完形填空”等形式的训练是学生巩固所学过的语法、词汇、句形等知识非常有效的手段之一。本书共分三个部分,第一部分为“完形填空”,第二部分为“首字母填空”,第三部分为“答案解析”。本书中的每一篇短文都是编者从近年英文报纸杂志、网络媒体等素材中精心挑选出来的,不仅难易适中、知识含量丰富,同时又妙趣横生、寓教于乐,目的是使广大考生在做题目的同时既能提高语言应用能力,又能增长知识、开阔眼界。编者针对学生学习中的难点、弱点对题目进行了精心设计,对答案进行了详细解析,以期广大考生能好好把握,认真总结,努力提高自己的解题能力,最终在升学考试中取得理想的成绩。
