

前言

人们一般用春花秋月、夏 雨冬雪来概括一年四季的特 征。下面这篇短文以优美的语 **盲为我们介绍了一幅引人入胜** 的四季图景,层次分明,分合 自然。

The Four Seasons

In a year there are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.

In spring, the sun shines brightly in the blue sky. The warm winds blow gently. The snow and ice can no longer remain. The little streams again flow merrily on. The flowers show their pretty shapes by the wayside and in the gardens. The trees send out little buds and new leaves. Farmers begin to till (耕种; 耕作) the soil and sow

the seed. All nature is clothed in green colour and seems very attractive and lovely. In summer, the sun shines blazingly and the heat is unbearable. But the days are very long and we can do much work. The thunder-storm will come often in such stuffy (闷热的) weather. All the sights are still fine. We have a long vacation in summer. We can go to many places to enjoy this pleasant season.

In autumn, the days gradually become shorter, and the nights longer. The weather is colder than that in summer. The mornings begin to be cold and the evenings are no longer warm. Farmers are reaping rice with scythes. It is the season for harvest. The leaves of the trees fall down. Most birds no longer sing, but migrate (候鸟等定期移栖) to warmer countries. In the mid-autumn the silvery moonlight become more delightful.

In the last season of the year, the weather is extremely cold. The roofs are usually covered with frost in the early morning. Snow-storms will come very often. Brooks and rivers will be frozen and the ground will be frozen hard too during the coldest period. All the insects sleep under the ground without eating. Nothing looks as fine as in the spring time.

Changes of the Seasons

In as much as the earth is round and follows an orbit round the sun, seasons are volatile. The four seasons are spring, summer, autumn and winter. When spring is mature, the plants and trees are prosperous.

The weather is mild and warm, so the green trees turn to its seductive appearance. There are less people who put on overcoats as the weather is warmer. The farmers are busy sowing the seeds. Everything appears promising in spring.

The concomitant season of spring is summer. Summer is much warmer, so there are plenty of people going to swim daily. They enjoy it as part of their pastimes. The bus-stops or terminal are with people queuing up in a beeline. There are also plenty of people going on picnic. Theatres, restaurants and shops are usually air-conditioned in order to attract customers. Someone says that summer is not a season for studying. I deem that the saying is wrong and it is an excuse for "lazy-bones".

Following summer is autumn, which is the best season for holding picnic. It has a cool, dry climate and I consider it the best season of the year. The leaves of the trees begin to turn golden yellow and rainfall is scarce. In the city, ladies who want to show off dress in autumn styles already. Swimming is unfavourable in this season, so picnic is held more often.

With autumn ended comes winter. Winter is cold. Ladies and gentlemen are dressed in thick clothes but many people only have little thick clothes to wear. Spring (1)

Spring begins on the new-year's day and lasts three months. It is a season of freshness and greenness. After the cold dreary winter months we are glad to see the leaves and to hear the merry birds. Summer

Summer begins with May and ends with July. The days gradually lengthen until near the end of June, when it is midsummer. The nights are very short, and sometimes very cool. The fields are now bright and

green. The trees and hedges (树篱) are covered with foliage (叶子的总称). The corn and rice are of a considerable height, though not quite ripe. The fruit trees are laden with their yearly burden. Towards the close of the season the grass becomes so high that it is cut down, dried in the sun, and stored away for winter use. This is called "hay-making" and it is a very common sight in the country during the month of July. On a hot summer day, one is glad to leave the dry, dusty road, and to wander through the fields or woods which are enlivened by the songs of birds. To them no part of the year is so gladsome as this, and they show their happiness by their continual song. Now we include in (沉溺于……;纵情……) outdoor amusements of all kinds, and wherever there is a convenient place for the game, a group of boys is always to be found, in favourable weather, engaged in cricket (板球运动).

The Hot Summer

The hot weather is rather unbearable. People can only enjoy a little coolness early at dawn and late at night. Once the sun has risen there is not any hope of coolness. At once the heat begins, walking in the burning sunshine becomes toilsome (辛苦的) and wearisome (疲倦的).

Perhaps it would be good if you could stay inside your house and keep fairly cool. But you simply do not have the luck, and have to go out, as most people have to do. Then you could not help feeling the full force of the heat of a blazing sun. You would feel it is like being in a hot house, and your shirt is wet with sweat. Sometimes the heat might be very dry and fierce, like the blast (鼓风; 送风) of a furnace (熔炉). The heat gets more and more intense until about six o'clock in the afternoon when the sun sets in the west.

But a hot summer day is not entirely without its charm. If you get up before dawn, you may take a pleasant walk. You will see there is just a faint light in the eastern sky and the stars are beginning to pale. A cool breeze blows and the birds are just waking. The grass is cool and dewy, the shadowy (多荫的) trees are rustling (发出沙沙声) their leaves, and the air is full of scent. Then you will enjoy the best part of a hot summer day.

A Pleasant Summer

In a pleasant summer the sunshine is very bright. The wind is very soft. The blue sky and the white clouds of various colours are very beautiful. The fresh air and transparent atmosphere are all but excellent. In such weather, our spirit is stirred up. We may either work or play.

Then the beautiful scenes present themselves to our eyes. The high mountains in the distance, the pure water in the nearby river, the green grass and the sweet flowers, the birds flying in the air, the beasts running in the wilderness, are all pleasing sights to the mind and the eye.
