旅游知识

Travel Agency 旅行社

A travel agency is a retail business, selling travel related products and services to customers. It represents suppliers, such as airlines, car rentals, cruise lines, hotels, railways, sightseeing tours and package holidays. In addition to dealing with ordinary tourists, most travel agencies have a separate department devoted to making travel arrangements for business travelers. Some specialize in commercial and business travel only. Some serve as general sales agents for foreign travel companies, allowing them to have branch offices in different countries from their headquarters.

The British company, Cox & Kings, is said to be the oldest travel agency in the world. Modern travel agencies begin with Thomas Cook in the late 19th century. Brownell Travel in 1887 is the oldest one in North America. With the development of commercial aviation from the 1920s, travel agencies become more popular.

As the name implies, a travel agency's main function is to act as an agent. Its profit is the difference between the advertised price paid by customers and the discounted price provided by suppliers. This is known as the commission. A British travel agent would consider a 10-12% commission as a good arrangement. In the United States, most airlines pay no commission at all to travel agencies. Travel agencies, in this case, usually add a service fee to the net price.

Reservation through travel agencies is a traditional way. Since the process of planning your trips and looking forward to new adventures is an exciting experience, finding a travel agent that meets your needs will help to make your dreams come true.

Brief information from the video

Consider Flying in Off-Peak Times: Flexibility is the key to an inexpensive getaway. Discounts can be found during off-peak times and seasons.

Try Flying into Nearby Airports: Once you pick a city, consider flying into nearby airports. Sometimes you can save a bundle arriving into one airport and leaving from another.

Be Flexible with Travel Dates: Research is essential to save your money. There are gobs of great online tools to help you find the lowest fare. Some even send you alerts when prices drop between your favorite cities.

Buy Direct from the Airline: Although these travel sites are great, they charge a service fee of at least \$5 when it's time to book. Don't even think about calling an airline to buy a ticket unless you absolutely have to. They all charge fees to talk with someone, in hopes you'll complete your purchase on the Internet.
